

Tier 2 Hollywood team are hot

In the second game, Georgetown played Woodville and outscored their opposition 3-0.

Joe Moneypenny earned a shutout in this game to advance the team to the championship round. Goal

scorers were Gary Morrow, Mark Waters and Don Latchford.

Georgetown played Halliburton in the championship round and the goaltending duties were shared by Joe Moneypenny and Derek Murphy.

Georgetown's Don Latchford opened the scoring at the 5:09 mark of the first period assisted by Rick Greenwood. Halliburton came right back and scored on Moneypenny to end the period at a 1-1 tie.

The second period was dominated by Georgetown with Rick Greenwood scoring a shorthanded goal at the 50 second mark with assists by O'Brien and Latchford.

O'Brien scored another shorthanded goal at the 1:12 mark with Greenwood assisting for a 3-1 edge.

It was O'Brien again connecting on a pass from Don Latchford at the 8:55 mark to end the scoring and win the tournament.
