The Georgetown Y's spring program is ready to begin for April. Once again the Y will be offering programs for preschoolers to seniors. Registrations are now being accepted for all programs at the Y at 89 Mountainview Rd. S. from Monday to Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. An evening registration will also be held March 17 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Y office.

The Y will be introducing new adult education programs for the upcoming spring season. A six-week Wok Cooking program will be held Thursday evenings at St. George's Church. Stained glass quilting will be held Thursday mornings at the Y for a six-week period.

Also new to the Y for this upcoming spring is a genealogy program that will provide you with an insight into tracing your "family roots". The Y will also be offering Wen Do, which is a special six-week self-defence program for women.

Conversational French will be offered for those who wish to improve their use of the French language for everyday conversational ability. Astrology II will be held Monday evenings for those who wish to learn how to calculate and interpret the results of charts. It is suggested that Astrology II participants have previously taken an introductory astrology course.

For all beginning bridge enthusiasts, the Y will be offering bridge lessons Wednesday afternoons from 1:30 to 3 p.m.

Other programs to be returning this spring are Astrology I, C.P.R. (Heart Saver), Cutting Your Child's Hair, and Training You to Train Your Dog. Discovery Days will be returning and the first trip is to Allan Gardens and village by the Grange next Wednesday (March 17). Other trips have been planned for Kleinburg, Kitchener and Cullen Gardens at Whitby.

Men's Sport and Swim will now be offered Monday and Wednesday evenings, for those who are interested in fitness, exercise, sports and a swim. (Please note, that the swim is only held Wednesday evening). Aerobics I and II which is a choreographed dance fitness program, Be Fit, Judo, Tae Kwan Do, and Social Dance are all returning for the Spring Term.

The Kwon Do will now be offered Tuesday and Thursday evenings. Adult Ballet classes will also be held Wednesday evenings from 7:15 to 8:15 p.m. For all beginning and intermediate tennis players tennis lessons will be offered Wednesday afternoons and Sunday evenings.

There are also new spring programs for children and teens. The Y will be offering a four-week Magic Workshop, French Fun and an arts and crafts "After 4 Club". Also returning to the Y for the spring is Babysitter's Training, For Girls Only, which is a six-week self-improvement program for 11 to 15 year olds as well as tennis for 8 to 12 year olds.

Gymnastics for boys and girls from 6 to 14 years will be held at Centennial Middle School Monday evenings. For all Tae Kwon Do enthusiasts the Y will be offering Tae Kwon Do Tuesday and Thursday evenings. The Y school of Ballet, which is under the direction of Sandra Williams and Elizabeth Chalmers will include Kinder Ballet, Preliminary, Primary, Grades 2, 3 and 4 as well as Adult Ballet classes.

P.D. Day Happenings for 5 to 12 year olds include a visit to Mountainview Farm March 15, a trip to Metro Zoo April 6, and of course a full week of activities during the March Break from March 22 to 26. Also during the March Break the Y will be offering a "Holiday at the Ranch" riding

program for 8 to 16 year olds March 22 to 23. The Y Aquatics program is held Sunday evenings at the GDHS Indoor Pool. There are lessons for all ages from tiny tots to adults and seniors.

Pre-schoolers have not been forgotten at the Y either. Playschool, Kinderfun, Kinderfun Outdoors, French Playschool, Parent and Tot Gym, Tiny Tumblers Gym, Pint Size Pottery and Kindercooking are all returning to the Y. The Y is introducing an eight-week "Creating Together" program for the child and parent to be involved in a variety of activities together. Also new to the Y is Kiddie's Corner, which is a combination of rhythmic, kinder games, music, songs, gym, crafts, creative play and drama for two and a half to 5 year olds.

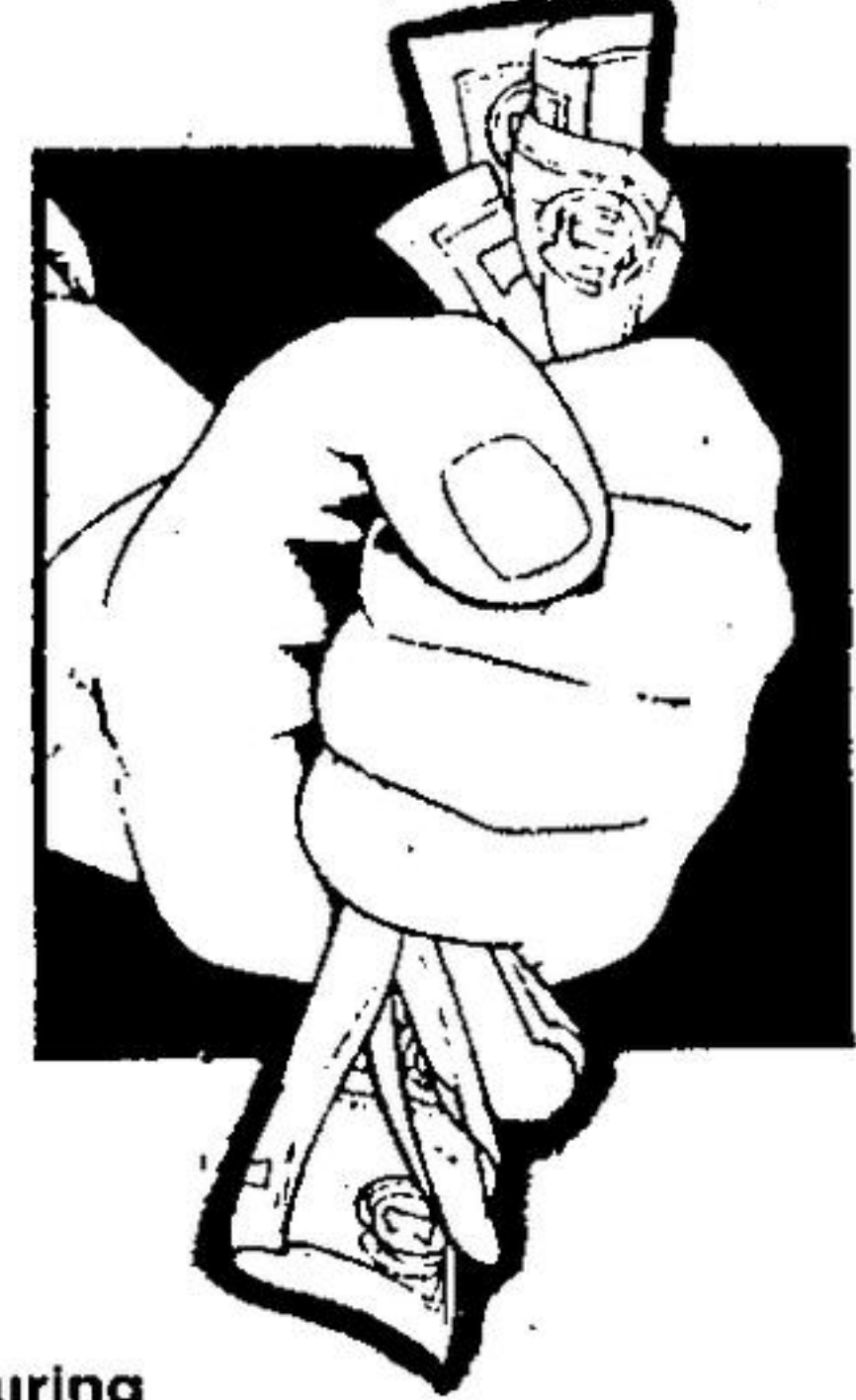

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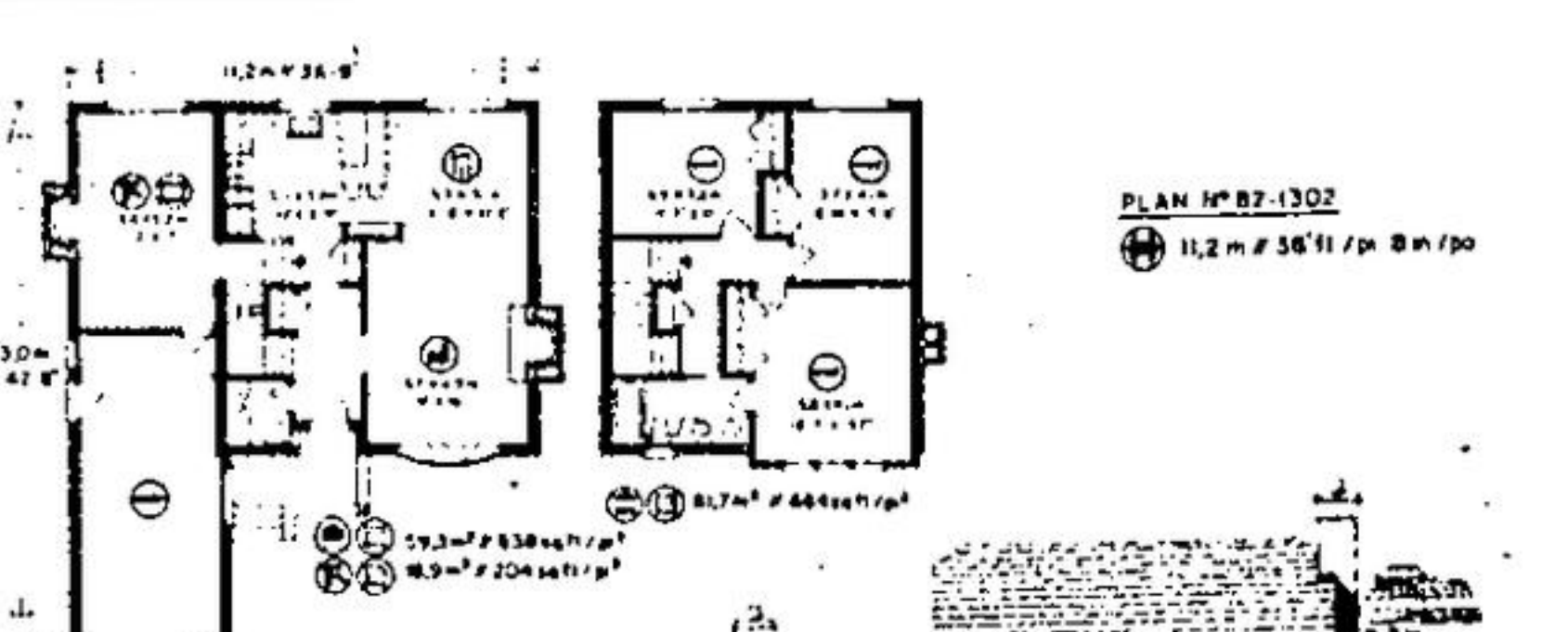
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STATELY URBANE THREE-BEDROOM BRICK TWO-STORY

This tall and elegant home design is perfectly suited to today's new fringe residential building lot, yet it provides in excess of 1,300 square feet of finished floor area on its two levels, for present use. A further area in excess of 200 square feet is available for future development as a sunken family room. The solidly traditional exterior is finished in mixed horizontal channel siding and brick veneer, complete with two brick chimneys, bow window and shake roof. For those who prefer, the roof could be alternately finished in more conventional shingles.

The elevated porch-style main entry leads into a compact reception foyer and outdoor storage area, from which traffic moves naturally to the right, into the long rectangular living-dining room combination. The living room features a raised-hearth masonry fireplace and a charmingly formal bow window set with small rectangular paneled windows. The dining area separates from the kitchen via convenient snack bar counter, for these casual family meals.

The spacious U-shaped kitchen has generous counter-top work surfaces, abundant cupboard storage and a step-saving work triangle configuration. From the kitchen three steps lead down to the sun-finished laundry room, which features a second raised-hearth masonry fireplace. A stairway leads down to the full basement from the landing adjacent to the family room.

A two-piece vanity bathroom is positioned adjacent to the reception foyer, and is accessible from all areas of the lower level.

A single enclosed garage connects to the family room, with sufficient space between the two areas for a mud room facility.

All three bedrooms are positioned on the second level, accessible via stairway from the reception foyer. Each has generous closet storage and good exposure for view and natural light. The large master bedroom has a separate access to the four-piece master bathroom, which shows double duty as an entrance hall.
