Dealing with your lawyer

Article 1: Trouble With Your Lawyer B) FABIAN WEINLES In our last article, we examined some aspects of a normal lawyer-client relationship. In this article we will focus on what you can do if you are dissatisfied with your lawyer.

One complaint clients voice is that the bills they have received from their lawyers are too high. (Sometimes people are shocked when they find out how expensive legal services can be. This is something you should be prepared for.) If you feel you have been charged too much, you can have your bill taxed (that is reviewed) by an officer of the Court. In Toronto, the officer is called the Taxing Master and he or she is located in the Supreme Court building.

Outside Toronto, you can have your bill taxed by the Local Registrar who is located in the local County Court Office. The fee for the taxing is \$15 and you must apply for a taxation within 30 days of receiving your bill. The Taxing Officer goes over the bill in the presence of you and your lawyer and will decide
