Rev. MacPherson said the church put emphasis on recruiting women for the two openings on the Session. One of the life-long positions was open due to the death of an elder and the other because the congregation had grown large enough to require a ninth elder.

NOTOFTEN Openings for the position don't come up often, considering the term of the position. The last time there were openings was in 1976.

Asked why women hadn't been chosen for the position previously, Rev. MacPherson said it was a long tradition of having men as elders, and it took time to break the ice and introduce women into the Session.

"However, we have two very gifted ladies now," he said

proudly. Mrs. McGee, a member of the Norval church for 37 years. said her husband had been an elder before he passed away six years ago, so she's carry. ing on the family tradition.

"It's a first for Norval Presbyterian and I think it's terrific," Mrs. McGee said enthusiastically. "I think it's a real challenge and it's something to sit in on their meetings and have their view plus my own views as a woman." She said there are often big

differences between the male and female points of view. "They're the majority, so you pretty well have to go along with them," Elder

McGce said. There are seven men and two women on the Session. Mrs. Carney, church


