It is most appropriate that during National Wildlife Week, April 5 to 11, this campaign that exemplifies public participation in wildlife conservation ethics is being

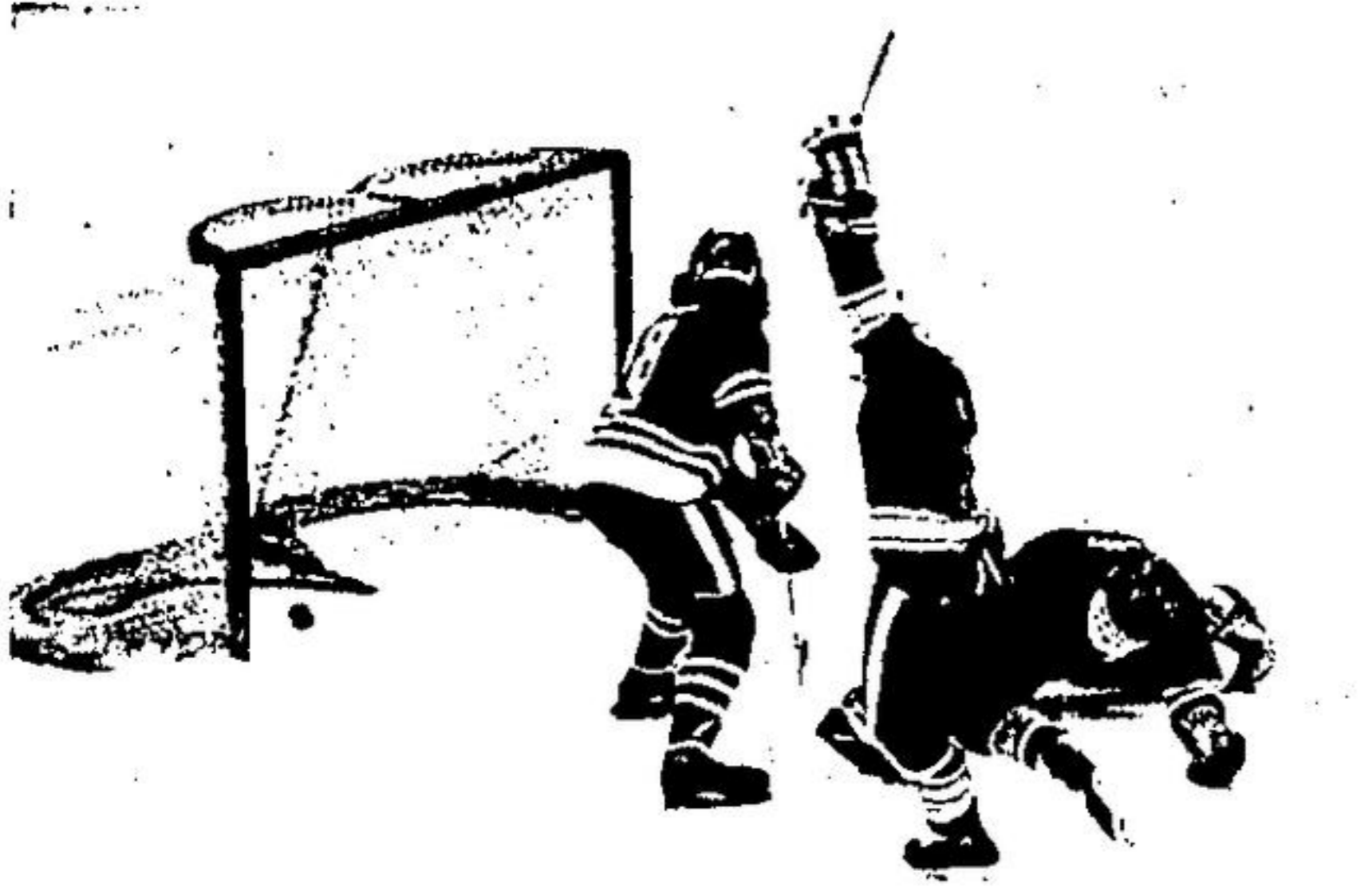

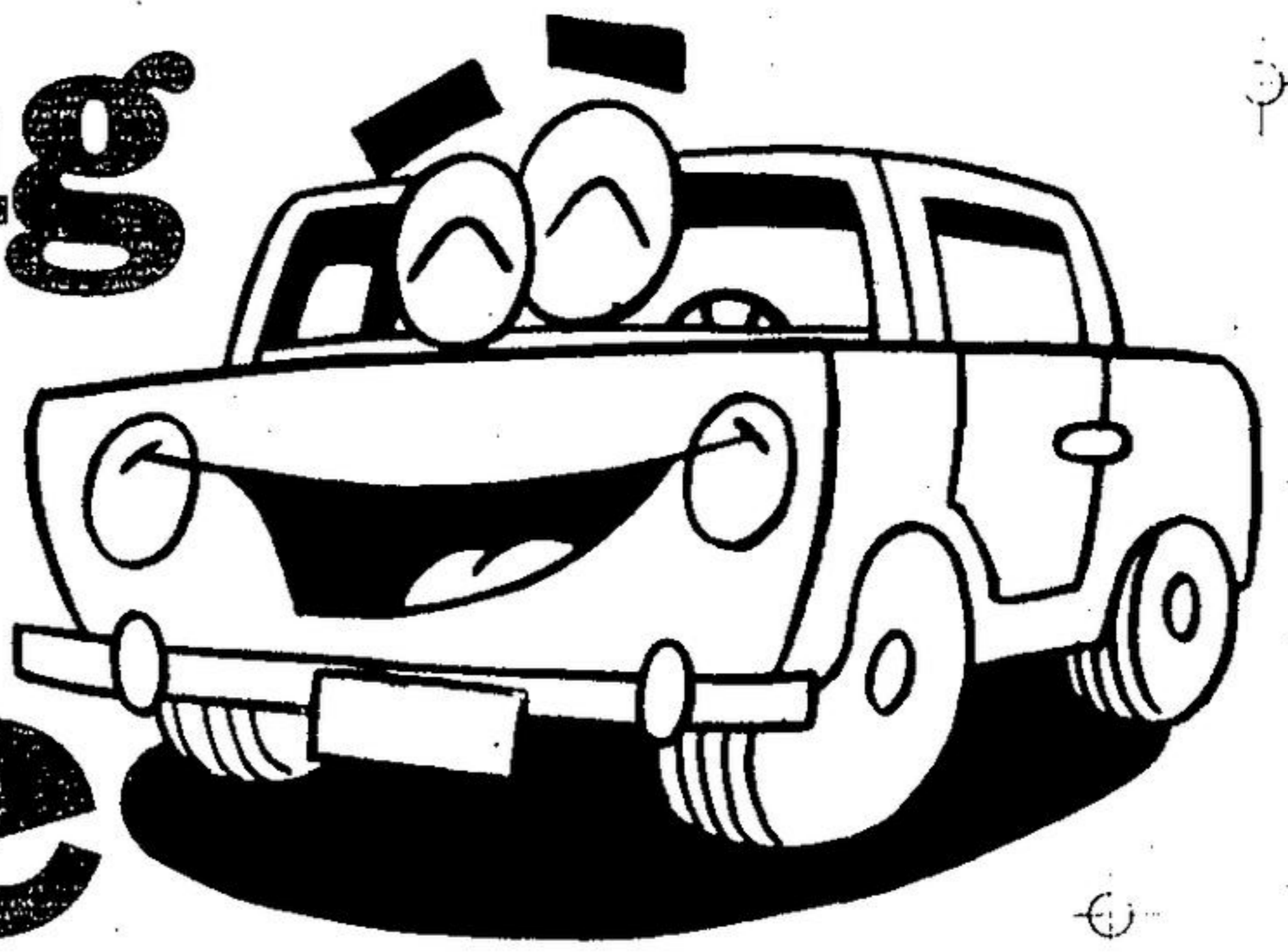
