

# Duplicate bridge

The fascinating thing about duplicate bridge is that the players of the game may arrive at several different contracts with the same hand. The reasons for this are many: aggressiveness, or lack thereof, conventions or interference, or lack thereof.

Consider the facts pertaining to today's hand. This hand was played by 18 different sets of four players. The most popular contract was three no trump. Of the 18 times played, 3 NT was bid seven times and was successful only four times.

Each time, the N-S pair played this contract, south played the contract almost the same number of times as did north.

Diamonds were tried. This contract varied between three and five of that suit and every time this diamond contract was played by north. It was tried six times but went off four of those times. 3 diamonds was successful twice.

Spades was the only other contract attempted. This was always played by south. It was never successful.

The moral of the story is that East-West do not need cards to

win at this game. They need only a few well-placed bids to force the opposition either too high or into the wrong suit as demonstrated above.

**THE ANALYSIS:**  
Those N-S pairs who find a way to stop in a diamond partial on this deal will earn

win at this game. They need only a few well-placed bids to force the opposition either too high or into the wrong suit as demonstrated above.

Look at the East-West holding and attempt a bid that will not encourage your partner and simultaneously cause the opposition to stumble. This was the hand.

near-top scores, with plus 110 a certainty and plus 130 a possibility if the defence slips and allows declarer to get rid of a club loser. At most tables, however, the contract will be an ill-fated 3 NT played by South.

Even if N-S happen to be using weak two-bids, 3 NT will be reached after North opens 2 Diamonds and South inquires as to his strength. When North shows a maximum and a heart feature by bidding 3 H, South will have no choice but to try the notrump game. The defence has two chances to beat this contract - the quick way, with an immediate club lead which yields four clubs plus the H-A, or the slow, agonizing route where West gets off to a spade lead.

East will have a difficult time finding the right defence if declarer, after the 58 holds in dummy, attempts to steal the heart at trick two.

The North-South winners at the Georgetown Bridge Club last week were Elsie Williams and Norma Maynard. Enid Ashworth and Judy Rivers placed second followed by Gus Flesch and Fred Allen.

The East-West winners were Art Norris and Mike Larusso. Second and third place were tied by John Flanagan - Peter Kakro and Marilyn and Ab Wardrop.
