

## Jerry Pate coming to Glen Abbey

Jerry Pate, who is fast becoming as familiar with water hazards as he is with the fairways beside them, has confirmed his entry into the 1982 Canadian Open Golf Championship. Royal Canadian Golf Association Tournament Chairman William Farlinger announced today.

Pate, the 1976 Canadian Open champion and winner of the recent Tournament Players Championship, joins course designer Jack Nicklaus and defending champion Peter Oosterhuis in the field who will battle for the Peter Jackson Trophy and first prize of \$74,500.

The 73rd Canadian Open will be played July 26-August 1 at Glen Abbey Golf Club, with 156 players in the field and a purse of \$425,000 and a series of Peter Jackson Daily Low Score Awards on the line.

"We are delighted that Jerry Pate will be returning to Glen Abbey for our Open championship," Mr. Farlinger said. "He is one of the most popular players on the PGA Tour, and in the past two years, we have been pleased to see him return to the form he showed in 1978 when he won both the Canadian and U.S. Opens."

Pate won \$280,000 and two tournaments in 1981, finishing sixth on the money list. The PGA altered his biography in the official Tour Guide to read: "Special Interests: Water skiing, hunting, fishing and some times diving." It was his victory at the Danny Thomas Classic in Memphis last year which ended a 30-month winless streak and sent him off on a new career as a lake swimmer.

Thus, when he won the TPC in March, he repeated his plunge-but not before an international television audience saw him hurl both Commissioner Deane Beman and course architect Pete Dye into a slightly alligator-infested lake beside the 18th green.

Pate's newly-discovered aquatic talents have added tremendous interest to the Tour's activities, as has his golf and his down-the-stretch battle in the TPC with his newly-acquired brother-in-law Bruce Lietzke, the 1978 Canadian Open champion.

Mr. Farlinger said ticket sales are progressing well, as are sales of Pro-Am spots. Golfers interested in playing in the Pro-Am or purchasing Executive Ticket Packages should contact the Canadian Open Tournament Office at 842-4633.
