

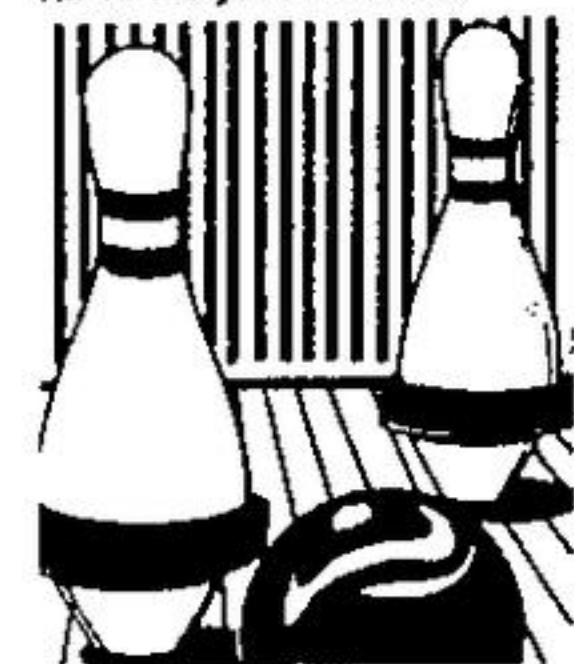
Bowling Family twosome champs
