SPLAKE STOCKING The ministry of natural resources are stocking Splake in the North Bay area. A total of six lakes will be stocked in the district, in an attempt to build fish stocks there. The ministry will also use "wild" parent rainbow trout to bolster

These fish will be taken from the Ganaraska and Bothwells creek, and a total of 120 rainbows will undergo extensive tests to see if they match up to accepted standards for propogating a strong, disease-free or resistant strain.

Yes, the perch are running. Shand Dam at Fergus as well as the usual areas such as Lake Simcoe are all producing bumper crops. The perch derby at Orilla is hosting about 1,000 entries and all are taking perch. The smelt runs have been, and are, good to excellent. When the

This Sunday, Mother's Day, is special at Black Creek Pioneer Village. The family admission price will be reduced to half price in honor of Mothers. Lots to see and do for the family, so why not treat mother to a day out.

Trout fishing has been fair to poor in this area. The large rainbow trout have not reached this for upstream in any numbers. A few have been taken, but this week will see good numbers arrive, and the fishing improve. The pond at Terra Cotta Conservation area has not been stocked. When I came back from Europe the phone had been busy asking what had happened.

The reason is the Ministry of Natural Resources claimed they had run out of fish and money. Hence the stocking dld not take place. Belfountain was stocked and Terra Cotta will be stocked in mid-May. Trout fishing has been the best in years around Owen Sound and the other well known areas and should remain so for a couple of weeks.

The Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters is still working for better firearms legislation. Warren Almand is still pushing his private members bill C-451 and the 28,000 member OFAH is still opposing it. The bill would make criminals out of law abiding citizens.

Many fishermen have asked me about the "new" triple Fish lines. These lines are not new, and have been produced since 1949 in Germany. If you wish further details I will try to show Triple Fish at my next open house. Dates to be released shortly, along with location.

Amalgamation is favored by a number of hockey minds from both the Acton and Junior B hockey Georgetown executives. We'll have to wait and see whether or not the obstacles can be avercome within the next few weeks.
