On a hot day it is important that people drink a lot of fluids - even for a 5.5 kilometre race, he says.

There will be water spots along the Mayor's Race route. On a hot day you can lose as much as 10 pounds and one gallon of water running in a marathon, Danielle says.

To simplify the age divisions, the women's entry will be the same as the

men's in 1982. As with last year, there is a team entry for an adult and junior who have the fastest combined time in the same family.

In the 5.5 k race, a trophy will be awarded to the first place male and female in each category while medals will be presented to the second and third finishers in each category.

A trophy will be also awarded to the youngest-oldest competitor and the first

male-female overall to complete the race. All entries who complete the race will receive a certificate.

In the 11.0 k race a trophy will be awarded to the first place male and female to complete the race while medals will be presented to the second and third place male and female winners.
