Halton Hills is increasing its municipal insurance coverage. The cost of insuring the administration and its property will rise from \$86,649 last year to \$86,963, although the town hopes to save \$2,700 on its coverage in the futre. Liability coverage will increase this year, covering the town against claims of up to \$10 million in 1982, more than double the coverage last year. In a report from Glenn Magnuson Ltd., the Georgetown firm managing the town's policy held by Frank Cowan Company Ltd., committee members were informed that claims against municipalities have increased in size and frequency.




