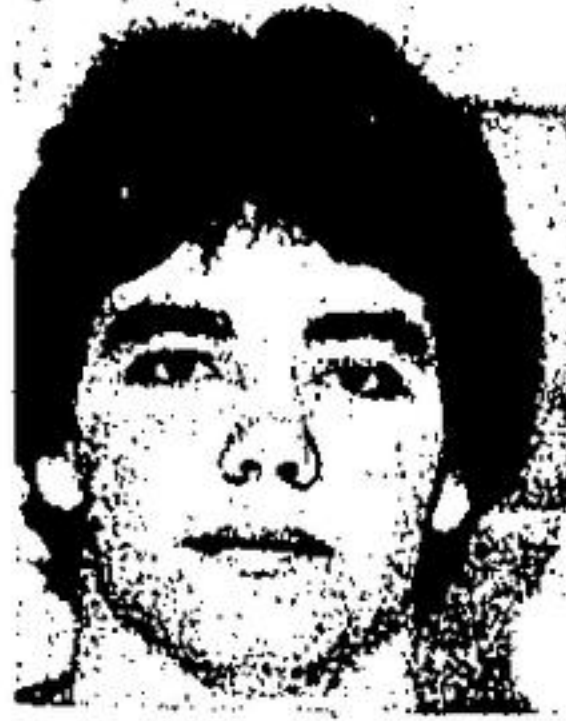


Meet the GBA Jr. Eagles

Paul previously played for the Bantam Reps and he is a student at Bishop MacDonell. Paul was born in Brampton.



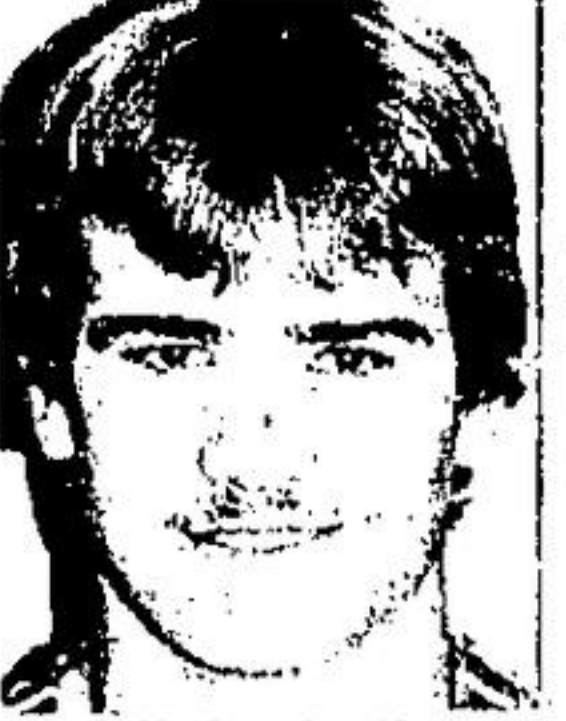
Gord Allan, Age 18

Smith, Ferguson pace GDHS team with track meet honors

Georgetown District High School distance runners Doug Smith and Chrs Ferguson powered their way to 8,000 metre, 15,000 m. and 3,000 m. victories Friday and Saturday at York University's Father John Redmond track and field meet.

In competing for their high school against competitors from over 50 other schools, Ferguson and Smith were awarded the Midget and Senior Boys athlete of the meet award.

The GDHS team finished an impressive third overall at the meet. Chris and Doug were the only members of the team to record first place finishes at the meet in Toronto.

In the high jump Joanne Bingham was fourth in the Midget girls category while teammate Kim Dryden was sixth. The Midget boys long jump saw Glen McCaughy leap to a third place finish.

The girls long jump was entered by Sue McLaren in the Junior Girls as she recorded a fourth place finish. Midget girl Susan Kerby was fifth in the long jump.

In the shot put Rich Slacey was sixth for the Georgetown

boys. Paul Burroughs was sixth in the Junior boys javelin while Kara McGaw was fourth for the Junior boys.

TRACK EVENTS
For the track team, Lee Blendell was sixth in the 100 m. with a time of 13.59 for the Midget girls. Jody Barwell was sixth in the 200 m. for the Midget girls.

Chris Ferguson won the first of his three races in the 800 m. Midget boys event while teammate Erik Hopkins was fifth in the same race.

Doug Smith was first in the Senior Boys 800 m. with Sandra Marcinik third for the girls in the 800 m.

In the Midget boys 1500 Chris Ferguson was first while Erik Hopkins was second. Senior boys 1500 was won by Doug Smith.

Louis De Paoli was fourth in the 100 m. hurdles while in the girls section Karen Edgar and sixth respectively in the 400 m. hurdles.

In the 3,000 m., the Midget boys event was won by Chris Ferguson, followed by Erik Hopkins in third spot. Doug Smith was first in the Senior boys while Lynn MacPhail

was third in the Junior Girls 3,000m.

In the Midget girls 4 x 100

m. relay, the team of Jody Barwell, Michelle Keess, Karon Buswell and Lee Blendell were fifth.
