GDHS environment students join nationwide Pitch-in campaign

If you happen to see an army of young men and women trying to fill colorful garbage bags along the main throughfares of Georgetown Thursday and Friday, they

aren't new town employees. They're Grade 10 environment students from Georgetown District High School taking part in the Pitch-In '82 campaign launched this spring by the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters in co-operation with Shell Canada Ltd. The May 10 to 18 campaign is endorsed and supported by the Ontario ministry of environment.

Together with teacher Bill O'Reilly, the students are taking a close look at what goes into their garbage bags. Their study will identify what kinds of wastes are being produced around town and what groups are spreading the garbage around.
