

Locals' cricket debut a success

Georgetown Cricket club made an auspicious debut to the first division of the Hamilton and District Cricket League on Saturday May 29 when the A team defeated the Oakville A team by four wickets in the opening game of the 1982 season at Stewarttown School ground.

This victory was due mainly to the destructive bowling of Ashley Windsor who continued his pre-season heroics and skittled six wickets for 20 runs while restricting the Oakville's total to a mere 50 runs. Windsor's performance was backed by steady bowling from Nirvan Balkisson and Neville Samaroo and superb wicket-keeping by Ken Jones who took three catches behind the stumps.

Oakville won the toss and elected to bat in overcast skies and on a rain-soaked pitch, conditions which turned out to be made-to-order for the Georgetown bowlers. Windsor and Balkisson had the opening batsman in trouble from the start and Balkisson drew first blood in his initial over when he had B. Sookram caught in the slips by N. Samaroo with the score at 5.

Noel Osborne, the other opener was joined by D. Weeks, but Osborne did not last long when he was completely beaten and bowled in Windsor's third over when the score was 19. From this point, the middle order batsmen, with the exception of Weeks, could not solve the pace and swing of Windsor's bowling and got out with unimpressive regularity, with at least one wicket falling in each of his next five overs.

The Oakville total went very quickly from 19 for two wickets to 27 runs for eight wickets and to this stage Weeks was the only batsman to offer token resistance by scoring 11 runs and hitting two splendid boundaries before being caught by Samaroo off Balkisson's bowling.

Georgetown looked set for an easy victory until K. Budrie, the next batsman, started swinging the bat as he was running out of partners and hit a towering six in the process. His luck ran out when Ashok Kumar, the new bowler, had him caught by D. Mongru at backward point with his first delivery. Budrie's score of 21 added some respectability to the Oakville's total of 50 runs when all 10 wickets had fallen.

The bowlers dominated the batting during the Oakville's innings and Windsor, who seemed to have re-discovered the fountain of youth, captured six wickets for 20 runs. He was ably assisted by the steady bowling of Nirvan Balkisson who bowled two wickets for 16 runs, Neville Samaroo one for 12 and Ashok Kumar one for 0. Ken Jones, the Georgetown wicket keeper, was very efficient and took three catches behind the stumps.
