# GLT makes booking changes

Following a very successful opening year in the new John Elliott Theatre, several major changes were considered necessary by the Georgetown Little Theatre. Facility availability and increased booking fees have made these changes inevitable.

Each play of the 1982-83 season will run for six nights - opening on a Friday, followed by the Saturday - then the next week Wednesday through Saturday with a new curtain time of 8 p.m. Tickets purchased at the door will be \$5.00 regardless of age with the excep-

tion of Wednesday and Thursday when students and senior citizens will be admitted for \$4. Tickets that have not been pre-paid must be picked up one hour prior to curtain or risk being resold and ticket exchange will be charged a 50 cents handling fee.

A survey was made of similar groups: the above policies are common practice with most of them and should curtail some of the problems we have had with being able to regulate ticket sales. The deadline for season ticket sales at last year's price has been extended to July 17, when the new rates will come into effect as follows: \$15 single; \$30 double; \$35 family (maximum two children); \$7.50 senior citizen; \$10 student (under 16). A new box office number, 877-3700, is in operation with an answering machine hooked up.

Do you have a budding Einstein on your hands? Consider the "Mad Scientist Club", which meets every Friday in July from July 9. It is

suitable for children nine and older. Registration is required. Other clubs available include the "Reading Club", the "Writing Club" and the "United Nations Club." These are all for the nine and over age group and require registration.

Special one day workshops include "Spy School", "Dinosaur Day", "Puppet Workshop", "Pirate Day" and "Mousetrap Day". All are suitable for children six years of age and over and all require registration.

Children of all ages are welcome July 7 for the "Summer Kick-off" at 3 p.m. at both Acton and Georgetown libraries. No registration is required for this or for the "Summer Finale" scheduled for Aug. 31.

Don't forget, Mother, that while your darling is being a mad scientist or munching to movies, you have a chance to browse through the book stacks in peace or visit the Art Gallery.

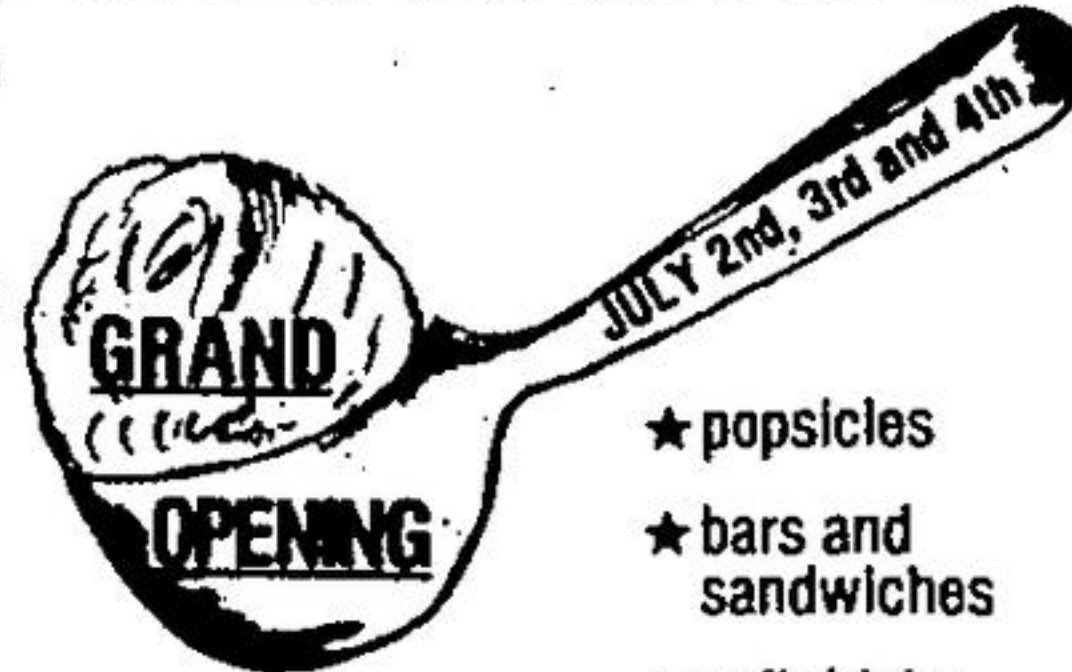

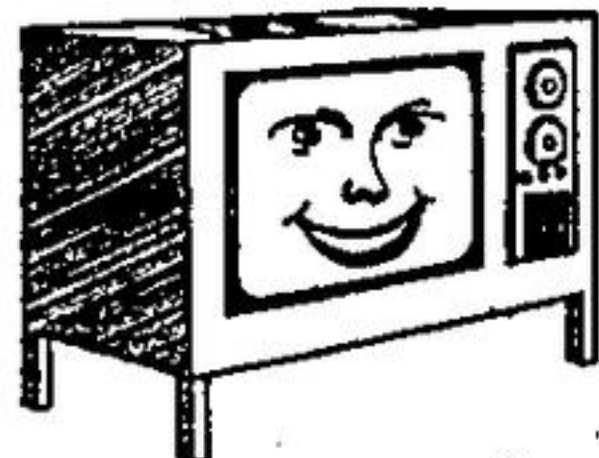
