Arcade owners seek changes

After an Ontario Municipal Board hearing told operators of the Garage Arcade on Acton's eastern outskirts that they must conform to town zoning bylaws, the owners approached council Monday seeking exemptions to the town licencing bylaw so that their business can be relocated.

Dennis Devine, speaking on behalf of himself and his partner, Mark Edwards, told council they have two prospective locations into which they can move their business if council will change the bylaw to permit it.

No location in Acton will meet the town's specified 300-metre distance from schools and residential areas. Devine said. While he would like to rent a downtown location the fact that there are apartments over the stores rule out that posslbility, he said,

When Mr. Devine and Mr. Edwards opened their business in November they rented an emply garage because no other commercial property which was suitable was vacant, They sought committee of adjustment approval to operate both the arcade and gas pumps at their site and were granted the arcade but not the gas pumps. The town appealed that decis-

ion and the OMB ruled in

the town's favor July 2.

While the arcade operators were following channels trying to get authorization to operate in their location the town approved a licencing bylaw which now prohibits them from moving into new quarters even though they could have done so prior to the bylaw passage had a place been available, Mr. Mr. Devine

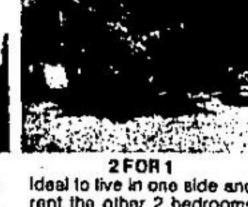

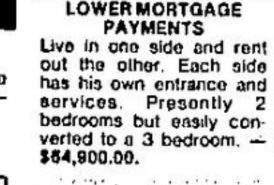
