CAS gets extra \$400,000

Halton's Children's Aid Society (CAS) and the province's ministry of community and social services ended ongoing budget negotiations last week, with the ministry granting the CAS an extra \$400,000 above the originally planned \$2.8 million budget for 1982.

In a press release issued after negotiations ended last week, Halton CAS executive director Ron Coupland said the additional funds will end the Society's "perennial problem of reviews and arbitrations in order to get our fair share".

"We haven't received all that we need, but the additional money has certainly taken the edge off the problem," he added. CAS administrators have long complained that the province hasn't provided enough money




