During this year one of the major projects was the production of a play...one which many other members will still remember with delight, "Marriage in Disguise". The play seemed to embrace the entire community in its cast, and the profit derived was turned over to the Community Swimming Pool fund.

A sad fact is that quarter of a century later the dreams of that committee for a swimming pool here, had not been realized. During this period applicants joined steadily.

An important decision was reached in August, when a pension committee was set up to investigate and present legitimate pension cases. A great deal was accomplished by it. Organizations meeting in the club rooms were charged the magnificent sum of 50 cents per night, and if heat were required 75 cents! The good old days! Even in this early part of events, the W.A. were helping the Branch, and managed to turn over respectable sums of money to help each year.

March 26, 1931, saw Com. Kelly reelected president and C.V. Williams and Arol O'Neill as vice presidents. Rev. W.R. Boyd was made chaplain for his fourth year. Zone Com-

mander Captain Innis, made an official visit and conducted the election of officers. During these years all phases of Legion work, such as the Armistice Day parade, Poppy Fund and Christmas Tree were constantly expanded and became important yearly milestones in the history of the community.
