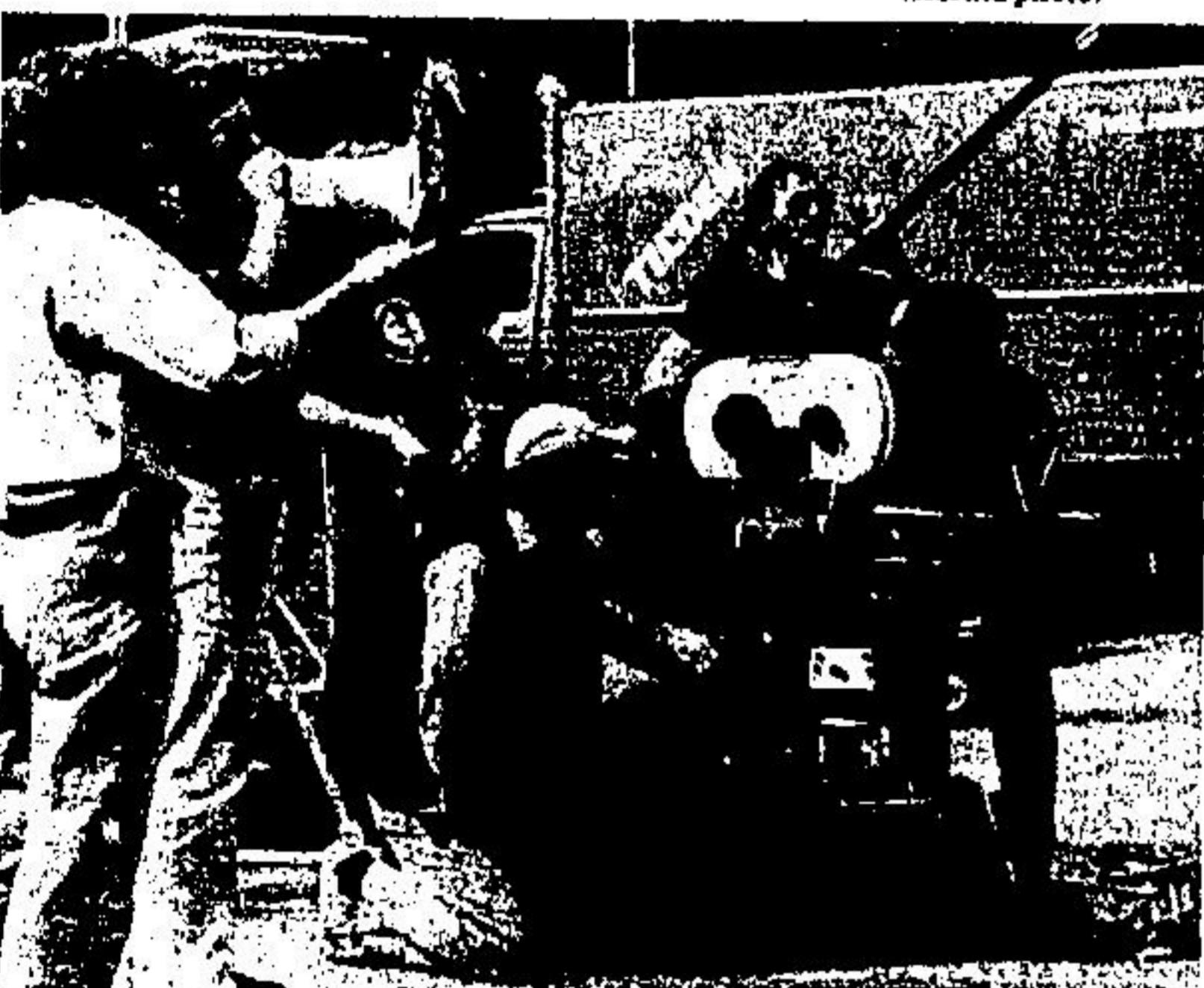


'TERRY' REVISITED
