Recommended a year ago by the Halton District Health Council, a home care program for the region's chronically ill begins Sept. 15. The Ontario ministry of health approved the program, but has yet to approve Health Council requests for chronic care beds for Halton Hills, Oakville and Burlington. With the go-shead given last June for 47 nursing home beds at Georgetown hospital, a new wing is scheduled for opening by the end of 1983.
