#### HISTORY OF BRANCH 129

It was during this year that the tremendous catastrophe engulfed the world and Georgetown, too, was

enmeshed in that economic horror "the Depression."

The Legion came to the fore then as one of the chief architects and supporters of the town relief plan. Executive, Poppy Fund, W.A. and members co-operated by raising money, clothing, food etc. One of the chief administrators of the central relief fund was the president Com. Kelly. During these years, still so vivid to many, the Branch's activity in helping in this work was tremendous as can be testified to by town officials of that period.

In the early winter of 1932, the firemen were allowed the use of the rooms gratis one night a month. Arol O'Neill became president March 24, 1932, with "C.V." perennial first vice and Bill Roney second v.p. Bert Parr was secretary and Allan Roney treasurer. During the year Bert Hurley also became secretary.

A breath-taking gamble was launched, namely the raffle of the new automo-

bile, climaxed by a monster carnival that fall. Over \$700 was realized on the car and promptly invested in bonds for a nucleus of a building fund. Building fund trustees named were W. Roney, J.D. Kelly and Gordon Brown.

Once again the Legion became alarmed at what they considered unfair

treatment to veterans and wrote to all levels of government asking that all things being equal, servicemen be given preference in public positions. Provincial Command began sending representatives and service bureau personnel out to the local branch more regularly.

## Georgetown man is certified
