Duplicate bridge

Slow play at the duplicate bridge table is both frustrating for the players waiting and for the opponents subjected to said slow play. This phenomenon occurs in at least two different ways.

One way is extremely careful play. The offenders play slowly so as to not make an error and to do as well as possible. Some hands can be very tricky and the careful nature of the offenders causes slow play.

The other way for slow play to occur is for a partnership to discuss a hand after it has been played and before their three or four board responsibility for that particular round has been fulfilled.

The director of the game must keep a wary eye on slow players. If a pair are guilty of the former (first) reason for slow play, the director is well advised to do his best to cause these players to catch up when playing the next boards.

If, however, the director finds that the latter case is the reason, he might be advised to be more direct in his approach to ensure less late plays.

In either case, as soon as a pair have fallen behind by one board, the director may and should assign the board to be played after the game has ended. In the event of two late plays when the same partnership has again fallen behind, the director may not assign another late play. He, instead, awards an average plus to the non-offending pair.

The rule of thumb for the director in assigning late plays is to allow approximately seven minutes per hand. View today's hand and see if you can bid and play it in seven minutes.

This is the hand.

N-S have a sure 9 tricks in spades while E-W can do the same in clubs. NS should therefore outbid their opponents. But life is not always that simple. E-W have the high cards to bid up to 3C but at many tables N-S may not even get into the auction.

After East opens 1 H, South does not have a good vulnerable 1S overcall. If he passes, West's 2C response (showing 10 plus) and East's 2D rebid will not make it any easier for him to bid the second time. Even if South does overcall at his first turn, it is by no means certain that 3S will be reached.

North will raise to 2S over West's 2C, North silencing East, but when West rebids 3C, North could justifiably pass and South will surely not act again. Those Norths who do bid 3S will be rewarded with a near top.
