# Duplicate Bridge Club

When the opposition arrives at a no trump contract in an auction that you must defend, the odds are in your favor that they (the declarers) have no eight card fit in either of the major suits.

Since there are 13 cards in each suit and considering the above, East should consider starting a heart suspecting that the opposition at best has only seven and possibly six cards in this suit.

This heart lead, at worst, is safe and could catch declarer in a weak sult.

Defenders are welladvised to consider such information whenever they must defend a no trump contract. If defenders have a suit that they can run immediately, by all means run it.

However, if defenders must guess, the major suit idea cuts your guess work in half. When all other thoughts fail for one reason or another, the old adage is to lead spades against no trump. This was the hand.

#### THE ANALYSIS:

N-S might reach 2 NT on an auction of N-1h, S-1s, N-2NT. This cannot be set but the defenders do well to hold declarer to 8 tricks. The only lead that surely accomplishes this is a heart, which gives nothing away while limiting declarer's maneuvering

In view of North's opening bid, East is unlikely to find this lead. He may, however, come off to a diamond, which gives West a chance to sparkle by encouraging with the eight but not taking the ace. North is almost certain to hold the K of diamonds for his 12 NT rebid, and by ducking. West will create doubt in declarer's mind which defender really holds the suit, which could affect the

N-Se best chance for a top is if South passes North's opening bid. West will probably balance with 2-D and if NS elect to defend, they may secure a 200. West has 6 losers going in and may lose a 7th trick if he leads 10-C when first attacking the suit. N-S are assured of a good score if North exuld double 2-D for penalties but South is unlikely to leave it in.



#### STATELY TWO-STOREY BRICK HOME WITH UN-FINISHED STUDIO

This impressively urban town home is ideally sulted to the very narrow residential building lot, yet If provides in excess of 1,400 square feet of finished floor area on its two levels. A full becoment and a specious un-finished area on the second level provide abundant space for the future development of additional accommodations and recreational area. The traditional exterior is finished in mixed brick and stucco, with barge board trim for durability and ease of maintenance.
