OHRP grants rise for physically disabled

Maximum loans under the Ontario Home Renewal Program (OHRP) are being increased to \$9,500 for physically-disabled homeowners or homeowners with physically-disabled relatives living permanently with them.

Municipal Affairs and Housing Minister Claude Bennett says that the funds to qualified applicants would be used for upgrading their homes to minimal municipal standards and making modifications that would lead to dwellings being more accessible to disabled persons.

The \$9,500 maximum is \$2,000 more than the amount generally available under the program.

This special loan maximum has been introduced because we recognize that modifications — to steps,

doors and cupboards, for example — will incur extra costs. The program will allow disabled persons to make those changes and live more

comfortably in their own homes," he says.
