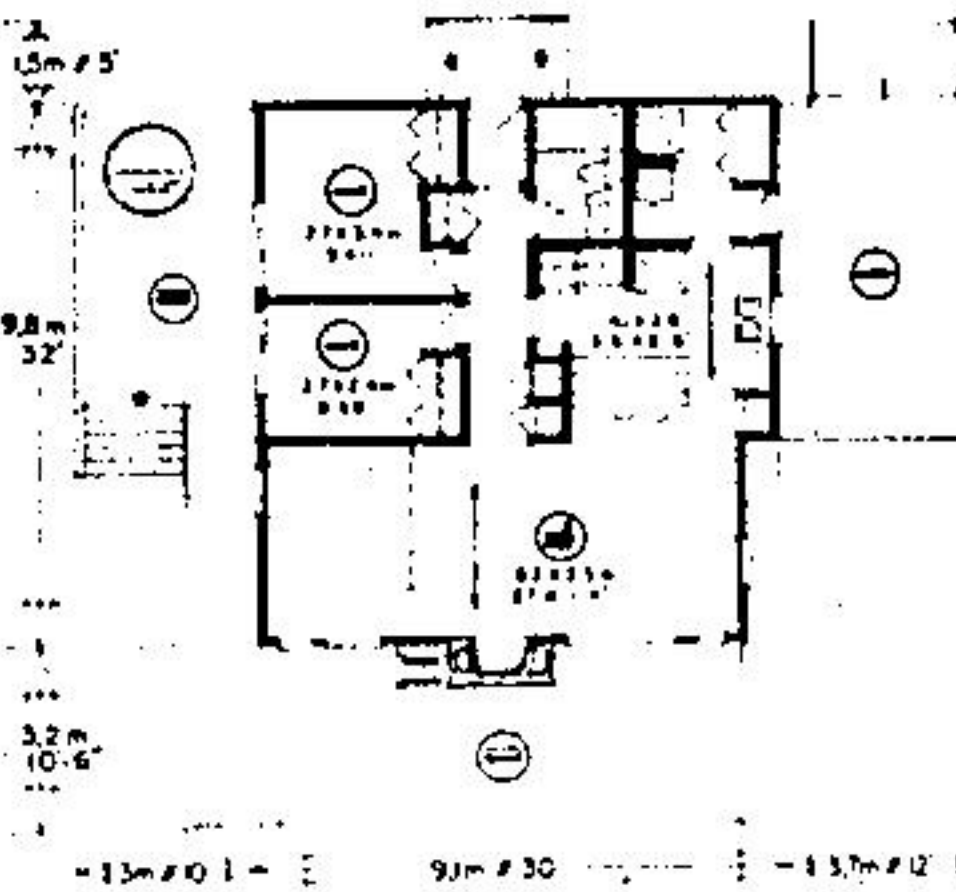

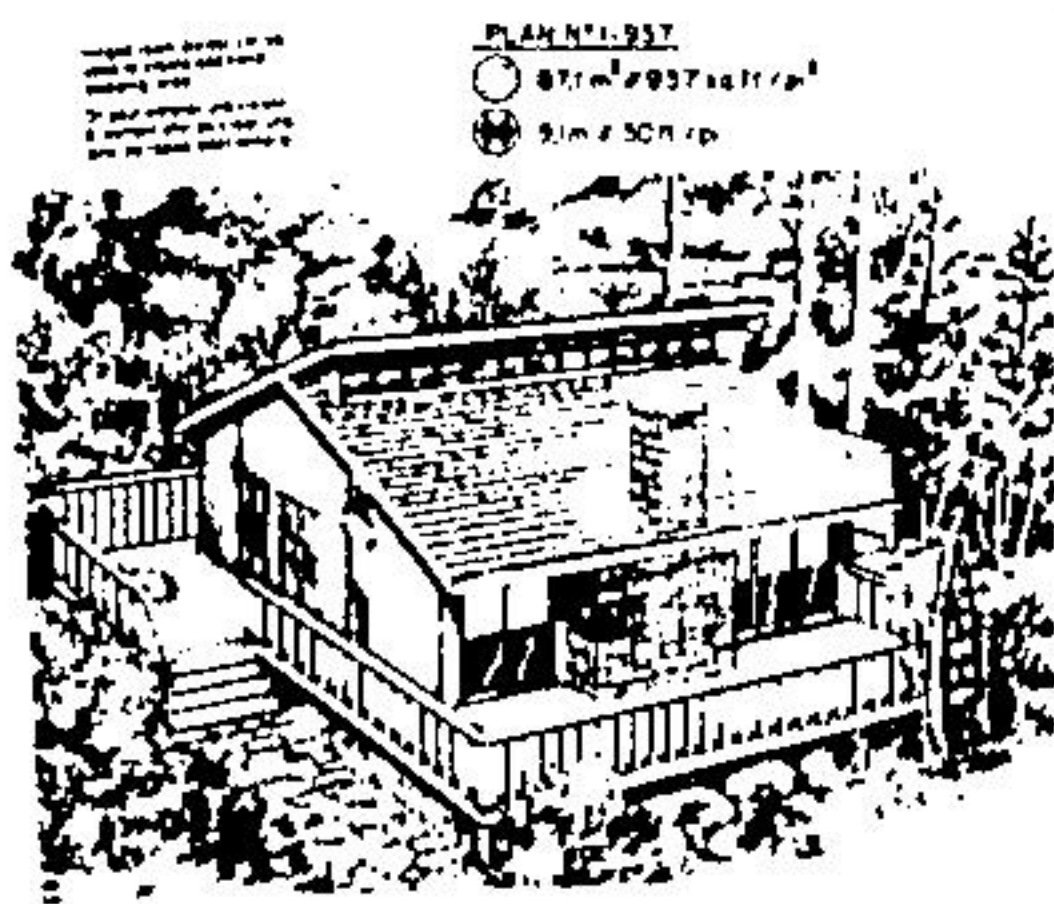

STYLISH & ENERGY-EFFICIENT LEISURE HOME

Here's a practical and convenient leisure home design which is ideally suited to the narrow frontage recreational building site, and which provides nearly 1,000 square feet of well-organized finished floor area. The vertical channel siding and shake roof of the exterior finish are designed to provide many years of maintenance-free durability, with high visual appeal and the ability to harmonize well with a wide variety of natural settings. A full-width row of clerestory windows on the soft-box roofline are designed to provide for natural solar heating if the building is correctly oriented with this glass area facing south. The roof could be alternately finished in more conventional shingles, according to individual preference and regional materials availability.

The elevated main entry leads into a compact reception foyer which, with the space-saving pocket door, forms an energy-conserving vestibule entry, or "air-lock." From the foyer, traffic moves straight down the hallway into the large rectangular living-dining room combination. The living room features a dramatic vaulted ceiling, a full-width sliding glass walk-through and a raised-hearth masonry fireplace with a built-in barbecue on the balcony side. The adjacent dining area features a hinged room divider wall which, when swung into position, creates an additional sleeping area for occasional guests.

The well-planned, galley-style kitchen provides generous counter-top work surfaces, abundant cupboard storage and a step-saving work triangle configuration. A wide work counter and snack bar divides the kitchen and living area, providing

seating for casual snacks. Adjacent to the kitchen is a convenient laundry-utility room, containing the heater, hot water reservoir, washer and a generous laundry storage closet. An entry from the single car garage enables the area to do double duty as a mud room.

Two finished bedrooms are positioned to the front of the floor plan, away from the main living area for freedom from disturbance. Each has generous closet storage and sliding glass doors which provide access to the wrap-around balcony. This balcony could easily have a hot tub or home spa installed for maximum luxury and convenience.

Plans for design No. 1-937 may be purchased either by the single set, at a cost of \$130.00 for the first set and \$25.00 for each additional set, or by the package. A five-set plan package, including the first set, is economically priced at \$185.00 and an eight-set package, also including the first set, is only \$275.00.
