Continued from page A1 off garbage, an increase of 500 cars a month since 1980. The station is open three days a week.

To accommodate the large volume of garbage anticipated if the firm handles all the waste collected in town, Leferink plans to buy a large compactor. Because of the urgent need to find something to do with the town's garbage before the full-service station is approved, the town has asked the environment ministry to waive the public hearing requirement under the Environ-

mental Protection Act. Under the agreement proposed between the town and Leferink, the expanded site would be open to town garbage truck traffic between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The agreement, which must be endorsed by the ministry, would come into effect Jan. 3 and expires

June 30. If the agreement is terminated early, Leferink is entitled to monthly compensation until the June 30 expiry date.






