Warranty has strong support

"Many people feel that some guarantees aren't worth the paper they are written on," Paul Tuz, president of the Better Business Bureau, said recently.

Based on the results of a recent opinion survey conducted by the Bureau, Mr. Tuz today reported, "An overwhelming 91 per cent of Canadian businesses we interviewed strongly back the concept of a Warranty Protection Programme designed to protect consumers against manufacturer default on warranties."

Retail businesses are particularly supportive of this idea. They see it as an important tool in helping to strengthen consumer confidence.

The survey of 220 Canadian firms is part of a full-scale investigation undertaken by the Bureau into the feasibility of a Warranty Protection Programme.

"The idea for the Programme initially arose out of reaction to the closure last year of Admiral, one of Canada's largest appli-

ance manufacturers," Mr. Tuz says.

Under the proposed programme, manufacturers of all products sold in Canada could be asked to acquire insurance to ensure that the resources are available in the event of their insolvency, to fulfill their obligations under their warranties. The amount of the insur-

ance could be determined on the basis of the manufacturer's assets, their time in business, and potential obligations under their warranties etc.

While businesses were conclusive in their support for a Warranty Protection Programme, a full 70 per cent agreed that compliance with such a programme should not be

imposed on manufacturers but should be offered on a voluntary basis.

Mr. Tuz pointed out that while businesses are anxious to see this kind of

programme put in place, "they have made it clear that administration of the programme should be left out of the hands of government."
