

Register Sat. for Artisans courses

With the harshest, dullest part of winter still ahead, maybe this is the ideal time to register for winter arts and crafts courses being offered by the Credit Valley Artisans.

Candlemaking, papermaking, pottery and weaving are as popular as ever or maybe the time has arrived when you'd like to try quilting. It's all available at the "Cottage", the Artisans' Cedarvale Park home adjacent to the community centre.

An introductory course in WOODCARVING runs Feb. 2 to March 9, covering types of wood, tools, design, 3-D layout, textures and finishes. Tony Bailey instructs the 7 to 9 p.m. course, the \$40 fee for which includes wood and tools.

Beginner QUILTING teaches students five different types of quilting for \$27. Norma Alexander's course runs for five weeks starting in late February, 7:30 to 9:30 p.m.

Beginners and intermediates will learn various WEAVING techniques on an Inkle loom and four-harness table loom in Jette van der Meiden's \$40, eight-week course (7:30 to 9:30) beginning Jan. 27. Materials are included.

In Grace McKnight's INTERMEDIATE ADULT POTTERY course, those who have mastered the basics of centering, throwing and trimming a four-inch cylinder can make mugs, bowls and plates incorporating handles, spouts, lids and foot rings. The \$47 eight-week course starts Jan. 25, running from 7 to 9:30 p.m.

And for those who've yet to learn the basics of throwing, Ms. McKnight also teaches BEGINNER ADULT POTTERY starting Jan. 24 for ten weeks, at a cost of \$57. The afternoon course (1-3:30) also covers glazes and use of the kiln.

CHILDREN'S POTTERY for beginners and intermediates runs Feb. 5 to March 12, Saturday mornings from 9:30 to 10:30. Connie Karlsson will teach the \$23 course. Also being offered are a series of Saturday workshops, for which students are asked to bring a lunch.

Avril Bull teaches CANDLEMAKING Feb. 5 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. You'll make several attractive and unusual candles to take home or give as gifts. Materials are included in the \$22 fee.
