

Forms readily available

Force follows complaint rules

A concerned Ric Morrow has asked Halton regional police chief James Harding to outline how a complaint against the force can be registered by citizens.

Chief Harding told police commissioners Thursday that the force follows the rules set out for citizens' complaints by the solicitor general's office.

A form available at all police stations allows for complaints to be registered against an officer or against the service a citizen has received from the force.

The complaint has to be put in writing, on what's called a "018 form". It's then followed up by an investigation at the district level or, depending on the seriousness of the complaint, at the executive level.

At either level, an impartial investigator is assigned to handle the case and prepares a report to establish the truth and lay the blame where it should be, Chief Harding said.

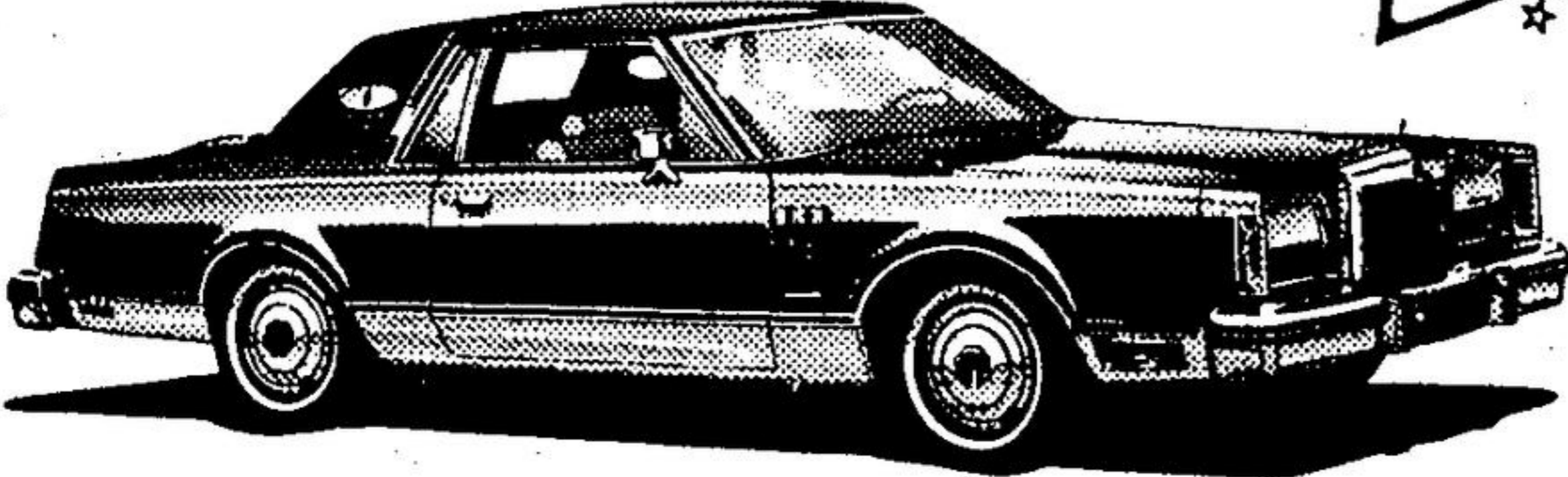

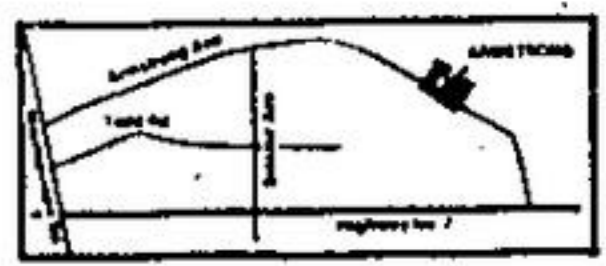
