Youth registration for boys and girls in both recreational and competitive programs, is at Zellers, Guelph and Mountainview Plaza, Saturday, Mar. 5, and Saturday, Mar. 12 from 9 a.m. until 12 noon.

If necessary, a late registration will be held on Thursday, Mar. 17, which will include a late fee. Yvette Spiller is co-ordinating the registrations and helpers are asked to let her know they are available - (877-8727).

Youth president Klaus Zander, says that the youth club has been taking a close look at the ratio of coaches and other officials to players for the upcoming season. It is likely that the executive will consider limiting numbers should the volunteers not meet the required number.

Competitive commissioner and minor bantam coach, Jack White, (877-0639) is searching for an interested coach for some 'rep' teams. The juniors are once again under the tutelage of George Balnes (877-5573). George is assisted by Dave Maloney (877-1867) and they have already been in touch with a few prospects for the team.

Gary Spiller, (877-8727), club secretary, is also looking after the major peewees, as he did last season. Bill Poole, (846-7787), is coach of the minor peewees, also returning after last year. The minor mosquitos are under the care of Nunzio Varrichio, (877-8820). The other age groups are in need of coaches, particularly the major bantams. There is a move afoot to form a league of Selects for the boys in the surrounding areas. Clubs like Orangeville, Erin, Caledon, Acton, Rockwood and some of our own teams are not too competitive with the 'biggies' of Mississauga, Oakville and Burlington. There is a feeling that we could build up to a more even set up within a new inter-district league. More on this later.

The girls will continue with the house league and select team leagues. They are looking to Brampton, Clarkson, Acton, Hillsburgh (new this season) and others to provide the competition.

The Inter County Senior Recreational League has its first 1983 meeting in Milton on Thursday, Feb. 17, at 7:30 p.m., at the Bayrischer Hof. Registration and budget for 1983 are on the menu.

The senior Falcons, coming of a reasonably successful year, are in the gym on Sunday afternoons from 2 p.m. - 4 p.m. George Balnes and Sam Ingills tell me that both teams will run in the Toronto and District league in the coming season.

The brand new Canadian Professional League is likely to obtain Canadian Soccer Association blessing this week when the official announcement will be made. There will be a Toronto team based in Varsity Stadium. The league is committed to homegrown talent. The comparison with the NASL Blizzard will be inevitable, and the outcome interesting.
