

# Tier 2 atoms defeat Burlington in semi-finals

The Georgetown Liftech atoms started and finished their Tier Two hockey league playoff semi-final round this past weekend, defeating Burlington in two games by scores of 3-1 and 4-2.

Georgetown on Saturday, Trevor Snow opened the scoring for Georgetown by deflecting Sean Gardner's shot from the point up over a sprawling Burlington goalie.

After Burlington tied the score late in the first

period, Georgetown's Bobby Bouskill scored the winning goal in the second period on a pass from Jimmy English. Sean Gardner then scored the insurance marker early in the third period, scoring from a scramble in front of the net. Snow and Jamie Tripp drew the assists.

The second game was played Sunday night in Burlington, and strong goaltending from the Burlington goaltender forced the game into overtime.

After a scoreless first

period, Burlington opened the scoring late in the second period when a Georgetown defenceman steered the puck into his own net while trying to clear it from in front.

Hardwork in the Burlington end finally paid off early in the third period when Georgetown's English shoved home a loose puck in the crease. Chris Lush and Chris Lorito drew the assists.

Regulation time came to an end with the score knotted at 1-1, forcing a ten minute overtime per-

iod.

Burlington scored from a scramble in front at the 2:37 mark of the extra period, but Georgetown battled back.

Chad Bailey tied the game at the 5:29 mark, on assists from Dale McNiven and Dave Watts. Then McNiven assisted by Dave Bewley and Steve Alchin, scored the winner at the 8:22 mark.

English, from McNiven, finished the scoring with a shorthanded goal into an empty Burlington net.
