Ease weeding

Reduce the hand weeding and cultivating required in shrub beds by trying some of the pre-emergent herbicides this spring. Even with their use, annual flowering plants can often be planted around the shrubs and evergreens for summer color. However, seeds generally cannot be sown in soil which has been treated with pre-emergent herbicides.

Colorful treat

Nasturtiums, sown in the vegetable garden will be a bright spot of color all summer and provide a continuous harvest of tangy peppery-flavored leaves and seeds for summer salads.

Garden guests

Now bugs and centipedes are usually beneficial garden guests, consuming decaying organic matter and waste products, and returning them to the soil as humus. Snails and slugs however, can be quite injurious, feeding on the foliage and roots of many garden plants. Traps for snails and slugs are available at most garden centres.
