### Crawford Lake fund grows

Members of the Halton Region Conservation Foundation are about to begin the second year of a three-year campaign to raise a total of \$700,000 to rebuild a prehistoric Indian Village near Crawford Lake and to create a new nature interpretive centre.

A Canadian Tire donation of \$1,000 has helped boost the campaign over the \$124,000 mark. The Foundation, which is made up of volunteers from all across Halton Region, will have to raise about \$100,000 in each of the next two years. The remainder of the funds is expected to come from a Wintario grant, government aid, and Halton Region Conservation Authority assistance.

About \$45,000 of the total raised so far has come from businesses in Halton. Another \$27,000 have been received in individual gifts from people all across North America. Banks and oil companies have donated more than \$18,000 so far.

Institutions have granted about \$3,000 to the project, and special events including a lottery for an original acrylic painting by Robert Bateman, have generated another \$27,000. Bateman and his wife Birgit are co-chairman of the Foundation's education committee.

Crawford Lake is meromictic: the water only partially circulates from top to bottom during the year. Because descending surface water seldom penetrates the layer of dense, oxygen-low bottom layer, there are no currents to disturb the sediment.

Sediment is deposited in distinct layers of light summer and dark winter bands, so dating material found in the sediment is as easy as counting down the number of layers from the top of the core samples.

The presence of corn pollen in the layers representing the years 1434 to 1459 led to the discovery of the remains of the nearby Iroquois Indian Village. The village will be the most accurately dated prehistoric Indian village in all of Canada, and only the second such community to be reconstructed on its original site.

Paintings by Jean-Baptiste Cote, Maurice Cullen, Paul Peel, Paterson Ewen and David Bolduc, and a sketchbook by Thomas Davies were added to the Canadian collection of the National Gallery of Canada last year.

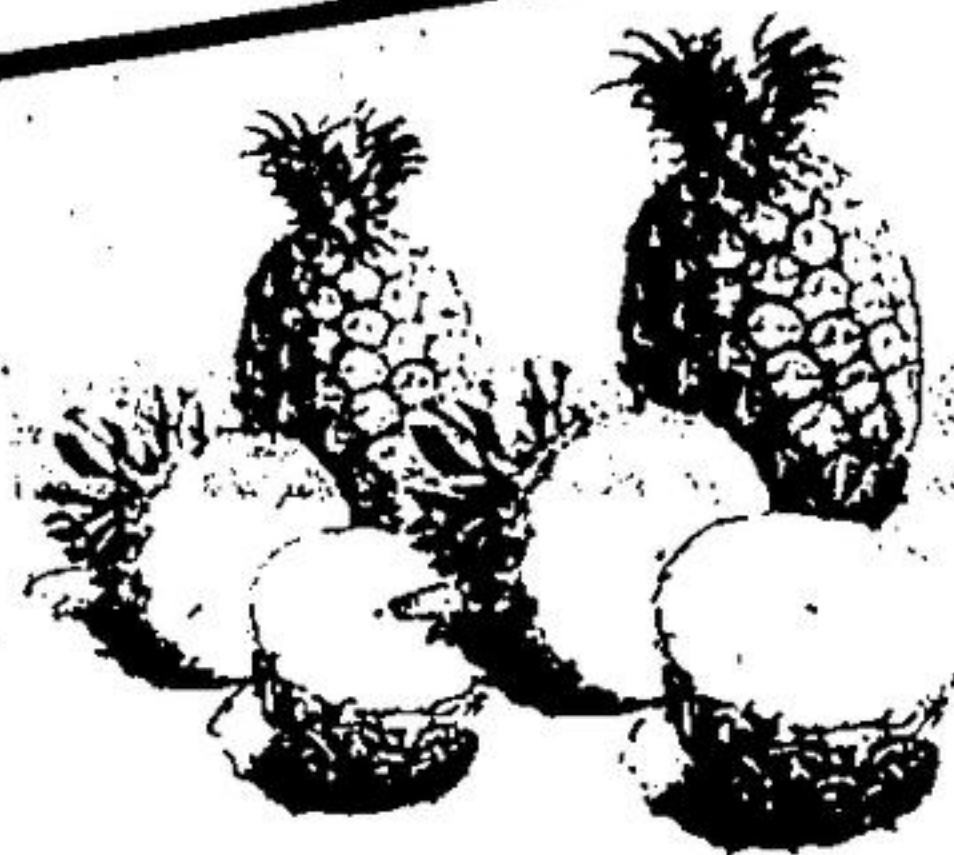
