Looking for an exciting way to spend a day in the country? Come and explore the Ontario Agricultural Museum at Milton. The Museum will be opening for its fifth season May 16th, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily until October 10th. The 32 hectare (80 acre) site is alive with activities and demonstrations which provide both rural and urban visitors an opportunity to discover Ontario's rural heritage.

Step into the past and visit an early 20th century carriage works with an operating wheelwright shop; or tour the reconstructed slaughter and smoke house. A fur farm and pump works are also new features for this season. The Museum offers demonstrations of pioneer farming and more than 25 buildings and displays will be open for visitors to enjoy. This spring, the Museum is busy plowing, planting crops and tending newborn livestock. Weekends offer a variety of special events to delight all ages.

Visitors can relax at the eating and picnic facilities, or explore the grounds by using the wagon transportation. Organized school and group tours are a specialty, but book in advance to get the most from your visit!

The Ontario Agricultural Museum provides an ideal outing for the whole family, young and old. The Museum is located 8 km west of Milton, on Townline south of Highway 401. Admission rates are Adults \$2.50, Students \$1.50, Children \$1.00, Seniors \$1.25 and a Family rate of \$6.00. For more information call 878-8151.

Respect for law

"RESPECT FOR LAW WEEK" is an annual observance sponsored by the Optimist Club of Georgetown, Ontario and has been proclaimed by Mayor Peter Pomeroy of the Town of Halton Hills that the dates of this observance, May 8 to 14 were selected to focus upon the related year-round activities of the 135,000 member voluntary service organization.

Through the Respect for Law program Optimist clubs in the United States and Canada have been exerting positive leadership by encouraging citizens to become actively involved in combating crime.

According to the Optimists, the first step in creating a climate in which respect for the law can exist is through establishing full cooperation between citizens and their local law enforcement officers.

In areas where this cooperation has been accomplished a measurable decrease in the rate of crime has been noted.

Optimist International's Respect For Law program was initiated in reaction to public apathy toward the increasing problems of crime. Since that time, Optimist clubs and other civic groups throughout the United States and Canada have become actively involved in programs and projects to combat disrespect for law and public apathy toward crime.

The Optimists are quick to point out their program does not reflect a blanket endorsement of the practices and personnel of all law enforcement agencies - but does emphasize the need for citizens to demand good law enforcement and to offer co-operation in every possible way.

Optimist John Kesteloot, President of the Georgetown Optimist Club has stated that this club will be observing RESPECT FOR LAW WEEK in the following ways: To recognize and award citizens and police officers of this community for their involvement in the reducing of crime.

President John asks all citizens to join with the Optimist Club of Georgetown in this observance, "Good law enforcement cannot be the responsibility of the police officers alone. YOUR HELP IS NEEDED."
