Time for a spring tour of the galleries. There's a lot going on locally in the Art Scene, why not get out and have a look at it. The Gallery at the Cultural Centre is devoting the latter part of May to an exhibition of School Art. Gallery hours are Tuesday - Saturday 2-3 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday 6-8 p.m.

The Forge Gallery in Terra Cotta presents an exhibition entitled "The Rites of Spring". You are

invited to view some exciting new works featuring blown glass by Denise Belanger, large sculptural planters by Robin Hollindrake, large abstract oil canvases by Valerie Mokrzycki, Raku pottery by Agnes Olive and watercolors by Jo Wallerson. "The Rites of Spring" will run until June 12. Gallery hours are 11:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. every day except Friday.

The Four Winds Gallery in Norval features paintings by David and Carol Vance. Hours are Mon., Tues., Wed. and Sat. 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Thurs. and Fri. 9 a.m. to 9 p.m.

She works in acrylics, watercolors and all drawing media. Mr. Ostermann makes his Georgetown debut with this show of stoneware and Majolica pottery. He is said to be one of the most exuberant of the young Toronto potters.

The Excursions Gallery in the Artisans Village at the Olde Hide House, Acton opens a new exhibition May 21. "Spectrum of Images" continues until June 8. Each resident Artisan is producing work for this show and each has invited one guest Artisan to submit pieces towards the theme. There should be an excellent selection of quality crafts represented.

As you can see, the opportunity to view is there. It is just up to you to decide on taking an "Art Amble," or "Gallery Gallop".

Day camp for children

It won't be long before children are finished school for another year. As over the past 23 years the local YMCA has provided opportunity for continuing the educational experience for children in their outdoor summer camps. This summer we will continue to offer Day Camp, with a special sailing option, and Creative Arts Camp.

Both Day Camp and Creative Arts Camp will operate four two-week periods, and one one-week period. The first camp period is to start July 4 and the last period starts August 29. The YMCA is pleased to announce the return of John Wood, the executive director of the Georgetown and District YMCA as the on-site Day Camp director, and the addition of Nancy Shortill, the program director of the Y as the on-site creative arts camp director. Under the professional leadership of these two full-time YMCA staff persons, you can be assured of a safe and enjoyable camp experience for your child.

At the Kelso Day Camp this summer, your camper will participate in canoeing, orienteering, fitness, games, sing-songs, an over-night, hiking, international education, camp skills, and swimming.

Ratio of counsellors to campers are maintained at 1:10 in all camps to ensure proper supervision and individual interaction with campers. The campers will be grouped by age, with a balanced boy-girl mix.

Nancy, in the creative arts camp, seeks to bring out creativity in campers and provide ample opportunity for discovery. Campers will enjoy music, dance, drama, art, swimming, games, a parent production and an overnight.

Special options to Day Camp this summer include French immersion and sailing. Campers registered for the French immersion option will participate in the regular Day Camp activities speaking French in small group activities and English in large group activities.

The sailing option will provide one hour a day of sailing instruction with the remainder of the time being spent in day camp activities.
