

Summer Safety Campaign

There are over 8,500 forest fires in Canada every year and over 1,600 of these are related to recreational activities. The 1981 losses and expenses exceeded 200 million dollars and 5.1 million hectares were burnt. Most forest fires happen in the four-month period from May to August.

The Halton Safety Council, which sponsors a Summer Safety Campaign, Awareness says campers and hikers can reduce the number of fires by observing basic fire safety rules.

Wood fires should be built in authorized areas only, on sand, clay or rocks. Clear away leaves or any combustible material and locate the fire downwind from campsite. Keep the fire small. Dig a trench if it is windy or if you have no stones to windbreak the fire.

Avoid loose, floppy clothing. Never leave a fire unattended and keep children away from it.

When finished with a fire, spread burned pieces and soak them thoroughly with water and cover with sand.

If you smoke, do it only in designated areas and never while walking. Dispose of cigarettes and cigars by crushing them on a rock, tearing them apart and grinding them into organic soil.

If you discover an uncontrolled fire, send someone to notify the nearest official. If the fire is small, beat it with a soaked sweat-shirt or bedding, working into the wind so you don't drive the flames into a new area. Rake and pull fuel away (leaves, grass, twigs, etc.) Make sure you have an escape route so you won't get cut off. Help the fire-fighters when they arrive.

Smokey Bear

The forest fire preventing bear in the ranger's hat is credited with saving many lives and avoiding losses of \$20 billion. Since 1945, when he was first promoted by the U.S. Forest Service, Smokey also has earned royalties of \$2.5 million that are funneled back into fire prevention. National Geographic reports. In 1950, Smokey's name was given to a real black bear cub rescued from a fire in a New Mexico forest. Following its death at the National Zoo in 1976, a new Smokey from the same forest was brought to Washington, D.C., and continues to attract 3 million visitors a year.
