Fobert's now leads the four-team loop, followed by Magnuson, Young's and the Blue Giants.

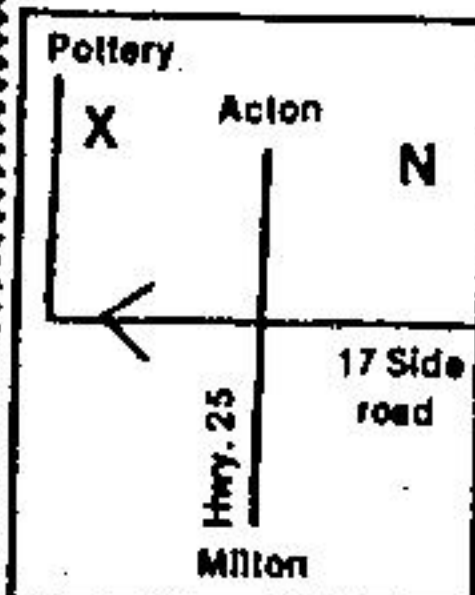

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application has been made for approval to expropriate the land described as follows: All rights, title and interest in the necessary lands, more particularly described as Parts 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 17, 19, and 20, on Reference Plan 20R-5595 deposited on the 7th day of January, 1982 at the Registry Office for the Registry Division of Halton (20) for the purpose of municipal road widening, and in particular, the widening of Regional Road No. 8-Steels Avenue-between Tenth Line and Winston Churchill Boulevard, in the Town of Halton Hills.

Any owner of lands in respect of which notice is given who desires an enquiry into whether the taking of such land is fair, sound and reasonably necessary in the achievement of the objectives of the expropriating authority shall so notify the approving authority in writing.

- in the case of an owner who is not a registered owner, within thirty days after the first publication of the notice.

- The Expropriations Act provides that,
 - where an inquiry is requested, it shall be conducted by an inquiry officer appointed by the Minister of Justice and Attorney General,
 - the inquiry officer,
 - shall give every party to the inquiry an opportunity to present evidence and argument and to examine and cross-examine witnesses, either personally or by his counsel or agent, and
 - may recommend to the approving authority that a party to the inquiry be paid a fixed amount for his costs of the inquiry not to exceed \$200 and the approving authority may in its discretion order the expropriating authority to pay such costs forthwith.
- "Owner" and "registered owner" are defined in the Act as follows:

"owner" includes a mortgagee, tenant, execution creditor, a person entitled to a limited estate or interest in land, a committee of the estate of a mentally incompetent person or of a person incapable of managing his affairs, and a guardian, executor, administrator or trustee in whom land is vested; "registered owner" means an owner of land whose interest in the land is defined and whose name is specified in an instrument in the proper registry, land titles or sheriff's office, and includes a person shown as a tenant of land on the last revised assessment roll;
- The expropriating authority, each owner who notifies the approving authority that he desires a hearing in respect of the lands intended to be expropriated and any owner added as a party by the inquiry officer are parties to the inquiry.
