The Environmental Impact Assessment for the truck storm sewer system to be constructed by the Town of Halton Hills as a part of the Guelph Street Reconstruction programme has been completed. This sewer is to be installed on Guelph Street from Sinclair Avenue easterly to Armstrong Avenue and northerly on Armstrong Avenue to outlet to an existing watercourse leading to the Credit River.

The completed Assessment report includes details of the proposed sewer route and an assessment of the associated potential environmental impacts.

The report has been submitted to the Regional Municipality of Halton's Ecological and Environmental Advisory Committee and the Credit Valley Conservation Authority for review. Copies of the document are available for review by the public during normal business hours at the following Town offices:

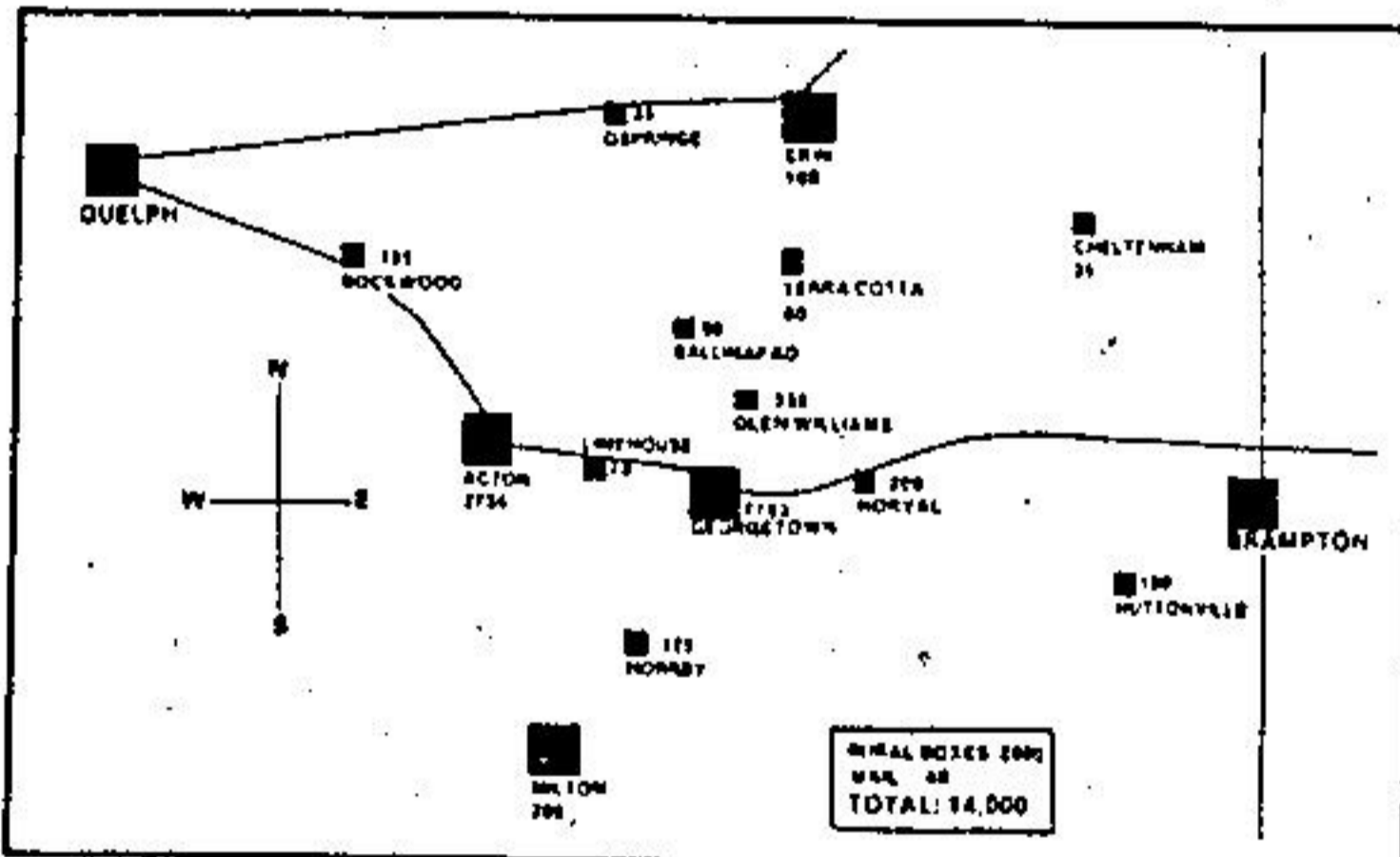
