Here's a smartly traditional two-story home design which is perfectly suited to the narrow-to-medium frontage residential building lot, and which provides in excess of 2,400 square feet of finished floor area on two levels. A full basement contains abundant storage space and additional area for potential development as family space requirement dictate. The nostalgic exterior is finished in horizontal channel siding, with tall masonry chimney and a high peaked roof. The latter could be alternately finished in shakes or traditional shingles, according to local material costs and availability.

The weather-protected main entry leads into a spacious reception foyer and outdoor storage area, from which traffic moves to the right into the long rectangular living-dining room combination. The living room features a raised-hearth masonry fireplace and a small-paneled projecting bay window, which latter could easily have a window seat on the interior side. The dining area separates from the kitchen via convenient pocket door, for ease of access and privacy.

The well-planned U-shape kitchen provides a step-saving work triangle configuration, generous countertop work surfaces and abundant cupboard storage. The kitchen separates from the spacious family room/denette combination via convenient snack bar counter. The family room/denette features a second raised-hearth masonry fireplace and a sliding glass walk-through leading into the wide rear patio.

Plans for design No. 82-2430 may be purchased either by the single set, at a cost of \$130.00 for the first set and \$25.00 for each additional set, or by the package. A five-set plan package, including the first set, is economically priced at \$185.00 and an eight-set package, also including the first set, is only \$235.00.
