Consumer confidence not yet reflected in retail sales: BBB

"Although consumer confidence has climbed to an 18 year high, the tills of most Canadian retailers are not reflecting this improvement," states Paul Tuz, President of the Better Business Bureau. in response to a Conference Board of Canada survey of consumer buying Intentions which claims that consumer confidence is strengthen-

Statistics Canada's preliminary figures show only a 3.5 per cent increase in retail trade over this time last year. "The fear of unemployment prompts Canadians to hoard their money and stops them spending it," Tuz explains. "Deposita in savings accounts in this country increased by 9 per cent between May 1982 and May 1983.

The consequences are being felt throughout the retail sector - sales are not rising at a rapid rate. Moreover, while many economic theorists are proclaiming the advent of a recovery, the real situation is that the bankruptcy rate continues to climb. The rate is 3 per cent higher than a year ago."

The President of the Better Business Bureau goes on to point out that consumers' disposable income has not grown, and this restricts the amount of money being spent, "Many consumers find themselves without money with which to express their new found confidence. Greater consumer spending is needed to get the economy rolling, but this will not occur as long as the country is suffering from unemployment. The only way to increase the amount of money people have is for



government to propose employment programs and to cut taxes."

Federal tax incentives and provincial sales tax cuts have boosted consumer spending in certain markets. For example, according to Statistics Canada, household furniture store sales increased

by 23.4 per cent and home appliance store sales by 22.8 per cent in May, and new car sales were up 18 per cent in June.

"If consumers believe that the job market will improve in the coming months and that the economy is on the rebound, purchasing will increase aubstantially."


