
While visiting, why not participate in the free summer activities.

Motorists not adjusting to new licence sticker

The Hamilton Automobile Club reports it is taking motorists quite some time to adjust to the new plate-to-owner system.

Under the computerized program, the Ontario Government sends car owners an "invitation to renew", 45 days prior to one's birthday.

The problem is most persons up for renewal think they must have their new licence sticker by the end of their birthday month therefore the long licence line ups near the end of the month.

What many motorists are not aware of is that one must have their new sticker on their vehicle by midnight of their actual birthdate.

As it stands now, there are thousands of motor-

ists driving their vehicles each month illegally because they are not validating their licence plate by their birthdate. Failure to have purchased the new sticker by

one's birthday could

result in a fine of \$28

under the Highway Traffle Act.

Since licence stickers this year are colour coded by month, it is suggested that you not take a chance on the system. Get your licence sticker on your car by your birthday!
