Truck save

TORONTO—Ontario's TruckSave program, a joint effort of the Ministries of Transportation and Communications (MTC) and Energy and private industry, will hold its annual fuel efficiency competition between Sept. 13 and Oct. 6.

MTC Minister James Snow and Minister of energy Phillip Andrewes will officially open the "Economy Challenge" Tues. Sept. 13.

The 7:00 a.m. ceremony, at Milton's Fifth Wheel Truck Stop, commences with both ministers driving a tractor-trailer through a banner.

The "Economy Challenge" is a competition for professional truck drivers aimed at encouraging fuel conservation. All types of trucks and tractor-trailers are eligible to enter the run in either direction, along Highway 401 between Milton and Chatham and Bowmanville and Kingston.

During the initial two weeks, competitors will drive during the day on the Milton-Chatham route today (Wednesday) and tomorrow and the Bowmanville-Kingston route (Sept. 20-22). To accommodate night shift drivers, the final two weeks competition will be held nightly on the Milton-Chatham route (Sept. 27-29) and Bowmanville-Kingston run (Oct. 4-6).

As last year, drivers will start and finish at designated truck stops where vehicle and fuel data will be recorded. Vehicles must also be weighed at a weigh station en route.

Winners and runners-up will be selected for six weight categories in four trailer-body classes.

Telex from Otto

The following Telex was sent today by Halton M.P., Otto Jelinek, to Prime Minister Trudeau, regarding the Korean Airlines air disaster.

"In light of the intentional and unforgivable action perpetrated by the Soviet Union against a Korean Airlines 747, killing 269 innocent and unprotected passengers and crew, including a number of Canadian citizens, I urge you to dispense with your traditional and simple diplomatic protest and instead take a more stringent and effective position, by immediately

recalling our ambassador from Moscow.

"Further, I urge that you order an immediate freeze on all ongoing negotiations and agreements with the Soviet Union until such time as Moscow offers an acceptable, international, iron-clad guarantee, which would cease any further actions of piracy.
