Orangeville controlled hunt

companies met to learn about the force and its computer needs. The closing date for computer proposals is Dec. 29, 1983, with evaluation of them expected to take three months. After that time, a contract will be signed with the successful bidder.

The move to computerization followed on the results of a 12-month feasibility study to establish the future automation needs of the force.

Police and civilian personnel who made up the task force strongly recommended automa-

tion of the records and communications systems. These recommendations were endorsed by police commissioners in February and accepted by regional council in March.

The steady increase in crime and the public demand for police services indicate that, in order to maintain levels of performance and to do so in the most cost-effective manner, the force's ability to obtain fast and accurate information is vital.

Police have been plagued with an increas-

ing flow of paper and an inability to compile and retrieve information

quickly. As the calls for service increase, more and more information is

needed for operational and management purposes.

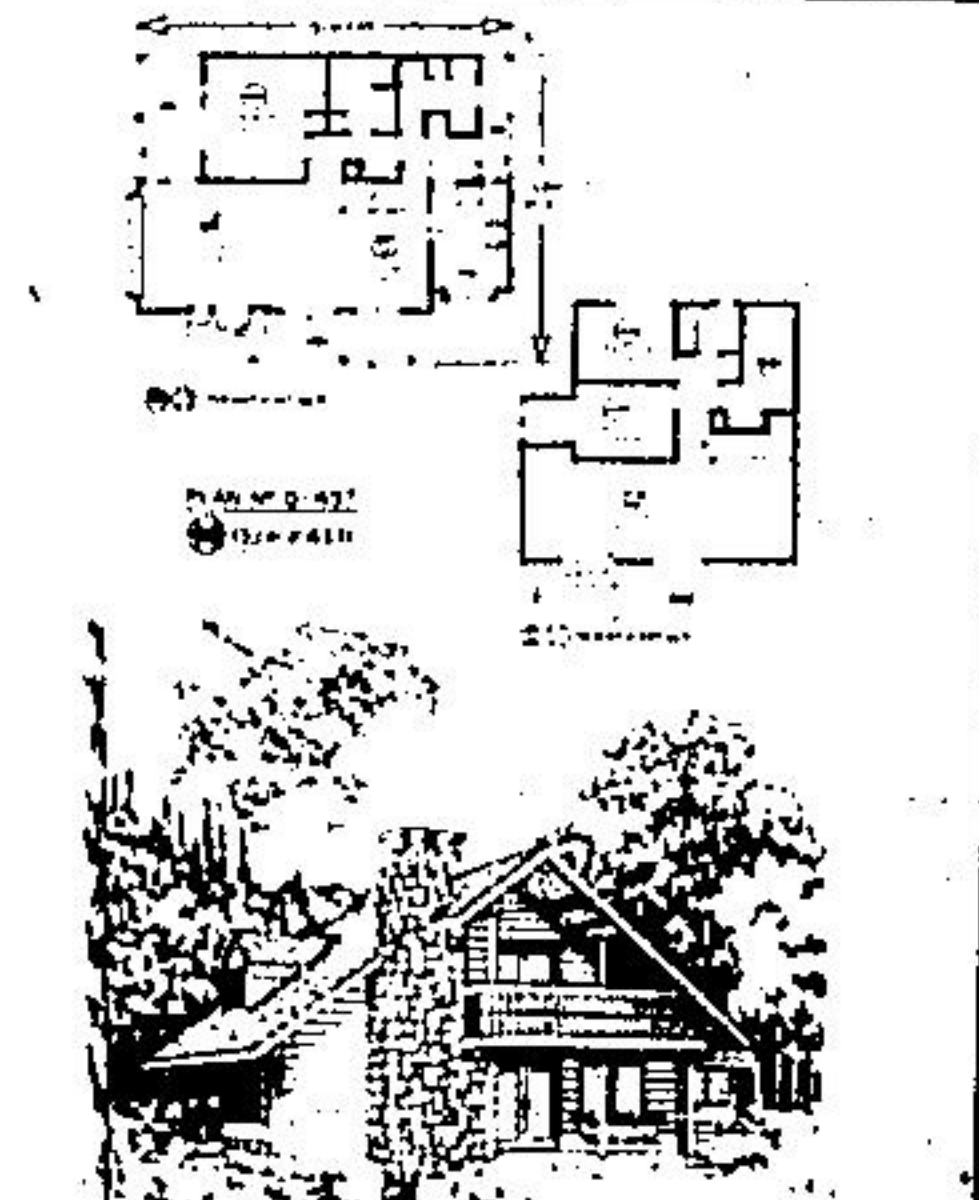

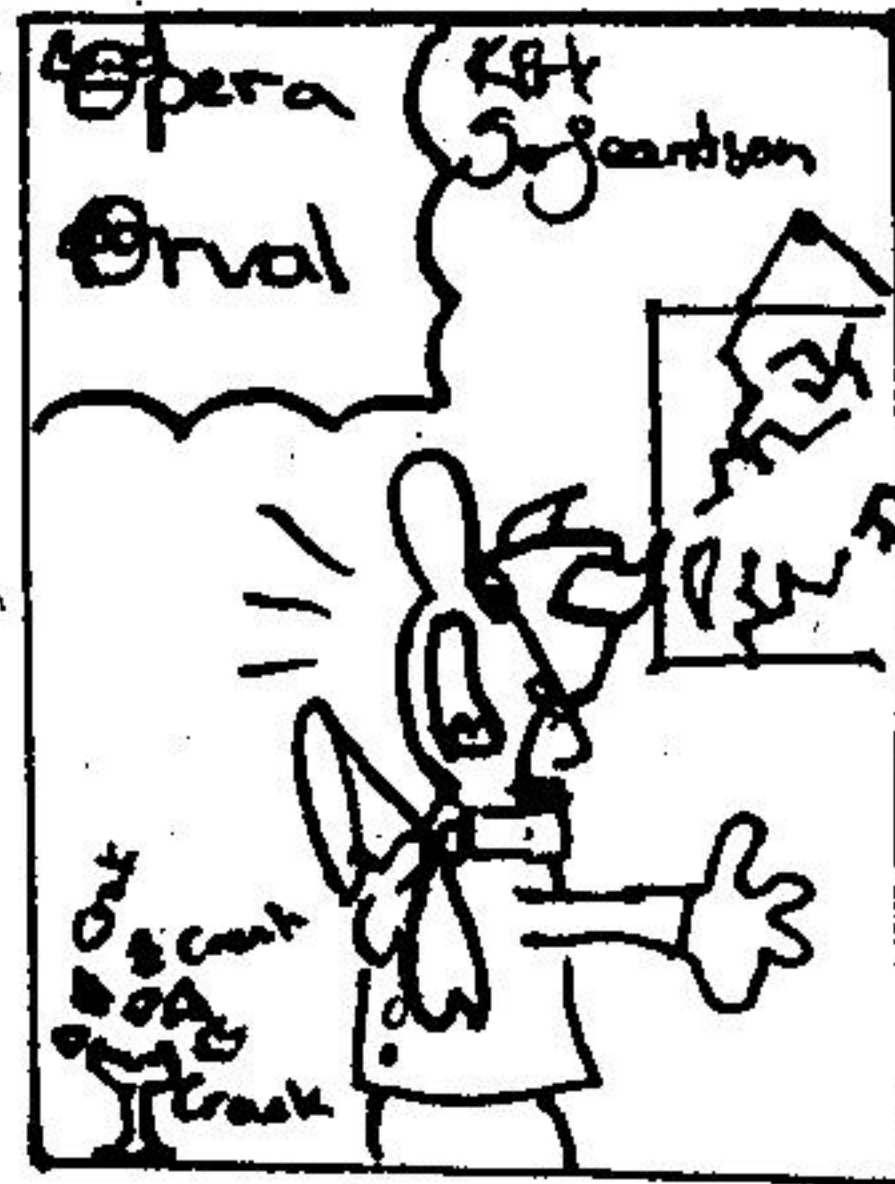
