Ryan Hay played a solid defensive game for Georgetown.

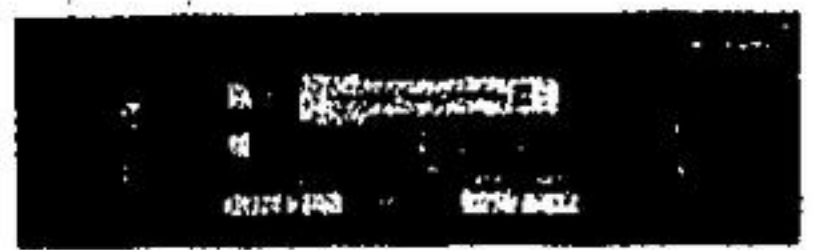

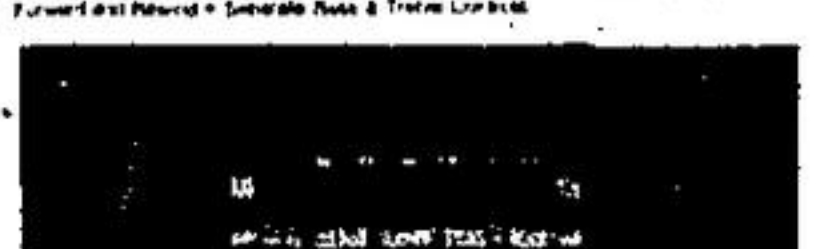
