

## Night studies boom

Providing post-secondary education "after hours" has become big business at Sheridan College, as high unemployment and a faltering economy force people to seek new career directions.

According to Sheridan's Dean of continuing education, Gary Britton, 35,000 Halton and Peel residents will have registered in 2,000 Continuing Education courses by the end of this academic year (April, 1983 through March, 1984). That's nearly double the 18,500 people who registered in 1976, and more than six times the 5,500 students who registered in the 1971 academic year.
