For industrial land plans

Trafalgar Road site best

Of ten sites examined in a recent regional study, only one is rated good for rural industry in Halton Hills.

The final report of the "Halton Region Rural Industrial Land Needs Study" points to a stretch of land along the west side of Trafalgar Road and Highway 7 between Maple Avenue and Regional Road 43 as being the most suitable location for rural industrial land in Halton Hills.

Other areas examined in the study include stretches along Highway 25, north and south of Acton; land on the north side of Highway 7 between Acton and Sixth Line; land on the west side of Trafalgar Road between Ashgrove and Stewarttown; Sideroad 17 east of Georgetown; Sideroad 10
