## Municipal centre

### No attempt to short circuit issue

The decision to appoint rather than elect a new mayor for the town was not an attempt to prevent the purchase of the controversial Stevens' property from becoming an election issue, town politicians say.

Councillors who favored holding an election to replace Mayor Peter Pomeroy denied there was any concerted effort by council as a whole or by the six members who favored appointment to circumvent public scrutiny of the purchase.

The Stevens' property is located on Maple Avenue, Georgetown, about two kilometers from the present Trafalgar Road town offices. Esqueusing Coun. Jake Kuiken said he was not lobbied to change his mind about favoring election and he is sure he would have been had there been any desire to keep the issue away from the public.

Finn Poulstrup said the Stevens' property had nothing to do with the issue.

"We bought the property as far as I'm concerned, it's over and done with. We all know what still has to be done and we're prepared to go ahead and do it."

"By the time an election rolls around it will all be completed," he said. "No one person on council whether it be mayor or councillor can stop that because the rest of council knows it's a good plan and they'll overrule him."

Dave Whiting and Marilyn Serjeantson both felt the vote on election or appointment was strictly an individual thing.

"I knew I voted for the purchase and I wasn't afraid to go to the public in an election," Coun. Whiting said.

"There was no conspiracy on council's part," Coun. Serjeantson said. "Obviously those who stood for election believed in it."

The fact that Russ Miller was appointed mayor will probably do more to allay fears of avoiding the issue because Mayor Miller is against the purchase and the idea of a new municipal office complex, she said.

No one would predict how citizens opposing the new complex and the land purchase of it will react to the appointment rather than an election.

Rick Bonnette saw finances as the choice in choosing between election and appointment. To him the Stevens' property purchase might have been in some councillors' minds but not with the impor-
