

Bowlers on top

After placing fifth in Peterborough, winning \$150, a team of young adults from Georgetown Bowl made it to the top of the ladder on the YABA Money Tour.

With a total score of 6668 (1317 average) over five games in the handicap division, the locals pulled ahead of their closest rivals from Bowl-Mor of Stratford by only 70 pins on Saturday at Dickson Bowl in Cambridge. This netted them a cash prize of \$850.

This achievement was powered by the exceptional bowling of Andrew Shenton, who rolled a 235 average, and well supported by Gary Richardson's 1196 total. The other members of the team were Diane Leonard, Sandy Cuthbert and Tom Elbourn.

CHAMPS WIN

The Tuesday Afternoon Ladies league Hi-Low Doubles team champs, Anna Ewen and Bonnie Jones came up big in the final game to win the zone title and a chance at the provincials, to continue Georgetown's successful efforts at capturing a Florida holiday trip.

After the first game, Ewen and Jones were 102 pins behind the leaders, Gord Lane and Ralph Miller. But the Men's League champs had a disastrous third game, placing second to the ladies, 37 pins short. This is the second time that Gord Lane has finished in the runner-up position for a chance at the Florida trip. Joe Foster and Dave Tales, the champs of the Wednesday Mixed League, placed third, only two pins behind Lane and Miller.

Ewen and Jones will now be going to the Sunbeam Bowmaster Provincials in Barrie, February 3-4, for a chance at one of four Florida holiday trips and over \$2,000 in prizes.
