 Pornography's aggressive "pushing of limits" is now being resisted by citizens groups and a growing number of politicians, Ms. Barlow noted.  
 She urged the audience to express their views on pornography to justice minister Mark MacGuigan and Ontario attorney general Roy McMurtry.

People should also write to the (Paul) Fraser Commission which is looking into pornography and prostitution in Canada.  
 Although reaction to pornography appears to be growing, Ms. Barlow also cautioned that the producers and distributors of pornography form a monied and astute lobby. Meanwhile, pornographers are using younger and younger subjects, Ms. Barlow said, adding that the federal justice minister is again planning changes to the country's Criminal Code to crack down on child pornography.

She read from the classified ads in the back of a catalogue of video porn in which there were several announcements for videos and magazines with children involved in sexual acts.

 The magazine, she said, was purchased from a corner store across from a public school one of her children attends.

Freely available to varying degrees on television, pornography is also being watched by young children, and Ms. Barlow questioned the values being adopted by its viewers.

"We are concerned about what they see at the movies," she said, "but do we ask them what they are watching on television?"

She wondered how a jury of the future—a jury of people grown used to the violence and degradation of pornography—would deliberate in a rape trial.

## Bridgehead

tea popular with local groups

There are many people in Halton Hills who regularly enjoy a unique brand of coffee and tea that can't be bought in stores. And while they are drinking it, they are helping to make life better for people in Third World countries.

"Bridgehead" tea and coffee is sold through several local churches, and is a delicious way for people to practise "being their brother's keeper" even if they are not experts on the issues of world development.

"It's excellent," says Nora Lipp, who buys it at St. John's United Church. "We serve it after church every Sunday", says Patricia Stuart-Hagge of St. George's Anglican Church. "And everyone enjoys it."

Holy Cross Church promotes Bridgehead products at bazaars and special events, and Trinity United in Acton sells it regularly. It was a popular item last weekend at a program sponsored by the local "Ten Days for World Development" committee, which strongly endorses these products.

Bridgehead Trading is run by a small, not-for-profit group in Toronto who import tea and coffee products directly from the people who grow them in Nicaragua, Sri Lanka, and Tanzania.

"When we started in 1981, we laughingly imagined selling \$70,000 in our first year." Instead, they sold \$120,000 worth in 1982, and well over \$200,000 worth in 1983.

"You might say that, whenever we drink coffee sold by the large North American companies, we are really being subsidized by the people of the Third World who must work for such low wages", says Janet Duval of the Georgetown Ten Days for World Development committee.
