**De-roofed**

If the embarrassing calls don't stop, call Bell's business office, and remember, Canada's Criminal Code provides up to six months in prison and \$500 in fines for making indecent or repeated harassing calls.

**I. D. program to help stop stereo thefts**

Crime Prevention Constable Bob Ustrzycki estimates that one in every 88 cars are broken into in the Halton Hills area yearly. Most of the time it's the car stereos that are taken and if you consider that most households have two cars, the chances of an incident like this affecting your family are roughly one in 40.

If you want an edge against thieves Georgetown Custom Car Sound on Sinclair Avenue has volunteered their services Saturday May 12 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The company will engrave your S.I.N. or driver's license number on your car stereo which will make it easier if you ever have to try and

retrieve your unit. They will also keep the make, model and serial number of your system on file which would also help if it was ever reported stolen.

Last year an estimated \$53,893 was reported stolen in car related thefts in Halton Hills. "Car related thefts seem to appear to be on the increase in the Halton Hills area," Constable Ustrzycki said. Estimated damage in gaining entry to the vehicles is placed at \$1,955.

Constable Ustrzycki said that this kind of service is offering free protection for the public. "Here is something for you, come and get it," he said.

**NHAMR Helpers pound the pavement to reach target**
